

Chapter 19

1 After this I heard what seemed to be the loud voice of a great multitude in heaven, crying out, "Hallelujah! Salvation and glory and power belong to our God, 2 for his judgments are true and just; for he has judged the great prostitute who corrupted the earth with her immorality, and has avenged on her the blood of his servants." 3 Once more they cried out, "Hallelujah! The smoke from her goes up forever and ever." 4 And the twenty-four elders and the four living creatures fell down and worshiped God who was seated on the throne, saying, "Amen. Hallelujah!"

2) Chapter 18 was the fall of the Woman, which hasn't happened yet. Here we see the judgement of the prostitute, which started in 1798 with Bonaparte, and was complete when the Vatican became sovereign in 1929. The ten horns and the beast burned the harlot with fire in 17:16. Then after that the horns give their power to the beast.

3) Forever and ever is a term that should read "age upon age." There are two ages, the age of the Jews (ended 70AD), and the age of the Gentiles. Age upon age goes to the completion of the ages, and is seen as Gehenna, as the final lake of fire in chapter 20. The papacy will not ever return to its former glory, it will remain smoke until the end. Just as the three beasts will be tormented to the age upon age in 20:10. The age upon age is the final judgement where evil is destroyed (17:8) and those that are in the Lamb's book remain to dwell in new Jerusalem.

5 And from the throne came a voice saying, "Praise our God, all you his servants, you who fear him, small and great." 6 Then I heard what seemed to be the voice of a great multitude, like the roar of many waters and like the sound of mighty peals of thunder, crying out, "Hallelujah! For the Lord our God the Almighty reigns. 7 Let us rejoice and exult and give him the glory, for the marriage of the Lamb has come, and his Bride has made herself ready; 8 it was granted her to clothe herself with fine linen, bright and pure"—for the fine linen is the righteous deeds of the saints.

5) Notice the separation of two followers of God based in the separation of Revelation 22:17.

Chapter 14 - followers of the lamb in verses 1-4

Chapter 14 - those of the spirit in verse 13, referring to those in the beast nations in verses 9-12.

Matthew 22:2-4 - those of the wedding party (for the marriage of the son) and those invited

Revelation 20:9 - camp of the saints and the beloved city

Chapter 11:11 - breath should be translated "Spirit"

Verse 10 - Worship God! For the testimony of Jesus is the Spirit of God

The Bride - Romans 11:7 What then? Israel failed to obtain what it was seeking. The elect obtained it, but the rest were hardened, 8 as it is written, "God gave them a spirit of stupor, eyes that would not see and ears that would not hear, down to this very day." 9 And David says, "Let their table become a snare and a trap, a stumbling block and a retribution for them; 10 let their eyes be darkened so that they cannot see, and bend their backs forever." 11 So I ask, did they stumble in order that they might fall? By no means! Rather, through their trespass salvation has come to the Gentiles, so as to make Israel jealous. 12 Now if their trespass means riches for the world, and if their failure means riches for the Gentiles, how much more will their full inclusion mean!

The Bride - Romans 7:1 Or do you not know, brothers—for I am speaking to those who know the law—that the law is binding on a person only as long as he lives? 2 For a married woman is bound by law to her husband while he lives, but if her husband dies she is released from the law of marriage. 3 Accordingly, she will be called an adulteress if she lives with another man while her husband is alive. But if her husband dies, she is free from that law, and if she marries another man she is not an adulteress.

The Bride of God in the Old Testament was the Jewish nation, led by the religious leaders of the Levites. The law had to die and it left Israel a widow. Here it shows how God will restore his bride to his son, fulfilling prophecies in the Old Testament. The bride is clothed in bright, pure linen, washed clean by the fuller's soap and refiner's fire (Malachi 3:2)

Jeremiah 31:31, 32 "Behold, days are coming," declares the LORD, "when I will make a new covenant with the house of Israel and with the house of Judah, 32 not like the covenant which I made with their fathers in the day I took them by the hand to bring them out of the land of Egypt, My covenant which they broke, although I was a husband to them," declares the LORD.

Hosea 2:19-20 "I will betroth you to Me forever; Yes, I will betroth you to Me in righteousness and in justice, In loving kindness and in compassion, And I will betroth you to Me in faithfulness. Then you will know the LORD. "

9 And the angel said to me, "Write this: Blessed are those who are invited to the marriage supper of the Lamb." And he said to me, "These are the true words of God." 10 Then I fell down at his feet to worship him, but he said to me, "You must not do that! I am a fellow servant with you and your brothers who hold to the testimony of Jesus. Worship God." For the testimony of Jesus is the spirit of prophecy.

9) Matthew 22:11 "But when the king came in to look at the guests, he saw there a man who had no wedding garment. 12 And he said to him, 'Friend, how did you get in here without a wedding garment?' And he was speechless. 13 Then the king said to the attendants, 'Bind him hand and foot and cast him into the outer darkness. In that place there will be weeping and gnashing of teeth.' 14 For many are called, but few are chosen."

9) Luke 14:21-23 The servant returned and reported all this to his master. Then the owner of the house became angry and said to his servant, 'Go out quickly into the streets and alleys of the city, and bring in the poor, the crippled, the blind, and the lame.' / 'Sir,' the servant replied, 'what you ordered has been done, and there is still room.' / So the master told his servant, 'Go out to the highways and hedges and compel them to come in, so that my house will be full.

10) Acts 2:38 Peter replied, "Repent and be baptized, every one of you, in the name of Jesus Christ for the forgiveness of your sins, and you will receive the gift of the Holy Spirit.

10) Acts 1:8 But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes upon you, and you will be My witnesses in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the ends of the earth."

10) Isaiah 55:1 "Come, all you who are thirsty, come to the waters; and you without money, come, buy, and eat! Come, buy wine and milk without money and without cost! Revelation 22:17 The Spirit and the bride say, "Come!" Let the one who hears say, "Come!" And let the one who is thirsty come, and the one who desires the water of life drink freely.

10) Isaiah 49:6 He says: "It is not enough for You to be My Servant, to raise up the tribes of Jacob, and to restore the protected ones of Israel. I will also make You a light for the nations, to bring My salvation to the ends of the earth."

11 Then I saw heaven opened, and behold, a white horse! The one sitting on it is called Faithful and True, and in righteousness he judges and makes war. 12 His eyes are like a flame of fire, and on his head are many diadems, and he has a name written that no one knows but himself. 13 He is clothed in a robe dipped in blood, and the name by which he is called is The Word of God. 14 And the armies of heaven, arrayed in fine linen, white and pure, were following him on white horses. 15 From his mouth comes a sharp sword with which to strike down the nations, and he will rule them with a rod of iron. He will tread the winepress of the fury of the wrath of God the Almighty. 16 On his robe and on his thigh he has a name written, King of kings and Lord of lords.

11) The horse described here has the same description of the horse in chapter 6, that came conquering and to conquer.

11) Faithful in the original Hebrew is Strong's Hebrew 539 (ne·'ě·mān) from the root 'aman, *The root נאמן revolves around firmness, reliability, and support. Whether describing a pillar that cannot collapse, a word that cannot fail, or a relationship that cannot be broken, the term conveys an unshakable stability that invites confidence. Its derivatives—'āmen ("Amen"), 'ěmūnāh ("faith, faithfulness"), 'ěmet ("truth")—all share this same sense of dependable certainty.* Read the rest of the descriptions at <https://biblehub.com/hebrew/539.htm>

11) True in the original Hebrew is Strong's Hebrew 571 emeth: *The noun נאמנה occurs about one-hundred-twenty-seven times across the Old Testament. While the English word "truth" often suggests bare factual accuracy, נאמנה embraces reliability, stability, integrity, and faithfulness. It is used for the very character of God, the content of His revelation, the ethical standard for His people, and the hope that guides eschatological expectation.* <https://biblehub.com/hebrew/571.htm>

11) Jude 1:14-15 Enoch, the seventh from Adam, also prophesied about them: "Behold, the Lord is coming with myriads of His holy ones / to execute judgment on everyone, and to convict all the ungodly of every ungodly act of wickedness and every harsh word spoken against Him by ungodly sinners."

11) Jesus comes on a horse, then it shows him treading the winepress. He treads the winepress as shown in 14:20 which is the Holocaust, so the army comes in WWI. In chapter 14 it shows Jesus coming on the clouds - the torrent of war. The fine linen is showing how he is our high priest. The great supper is the fall of the nations. There are many **actual reports** of this angelic army recorded from WWI and WWII. The presence of this heavenly army was witnessed over and over. 11) 2 Thessalonians 1:5 This is evidence of the righteous judgment of God, that you may be considered worthy of the kingdom of God, for which you are also suffering— 6 since indeed God considers it just to repay with affliction those who afflict you, 7 and to grant relief to you who are afflicted as well as to us, when the Lord Jesus is revealed from heaven with his mighty angels 8 in flaming fire, inflicting vengeance on those who do not know God and on those who do not obey the gospel of our Lord Jesus. 9 They will suffer the punishment of eternal destruction, away from the presence of the Lord and from the glory of his might, 10 when he comes on that day to be glorified in his saints, and to be marveled at among all who have believed, because our testimony to you was believed.

12) See Rev 1:14 for the eyes like fire. He is the king of kings, the crowns upon crowns. The name he is marked with is likely the name of God, the most high, which has not been revealed at this time. In the early 1900s, God is still known as LORD, even now there is not an agreement to which name to call the Most High.

13) Isaiah 63:1-4 Who is this coming from Edom, from Bozrah with crimson-stained garments? Who is this robed in splendor, marching in the greatness of His strength? "It is I, proclaiming vindication, mighty to save." / Why are Your clothes red, and Your garments like one who treads the winepress? / "I have trodden the winepress alone, and no one from the nations was with Me. I trampled them in My anger and trod them down in My fury; their blood spattered My garments, and all My clothes were stained.

14) There is literal proof of the heavenly army, but prophetically speaking, those that armor up and fight the good fight are also the army of Jesus. We are to take dominion as Paul says in Ephesians 6. We are to take captive as he also says in 2 Corinthians 10:5, and we are to crucify as in Galatians 5:24. There is a daily battle as described in Romans 7-8 that only the Spirit of God will help us to win.

16) The thigh is the place of covenant (Genesis 24:9), and the place of the sword (Judges 3:21).

16) See Jacob's robe (Genesis 37:3) a priestly robe (Exodus 28:4) and a royal robe (1 Samuel 24:4-5).

17 Then I saw an angel standing in the sun, and with a loud voice he called to all the birds that fly directly overhead, "Come, gather for the great supper of God, men, both free and slave, both small and great." to eat the flesh of kings, the flesh of captains, the flesh of mighty men, the flesh of horses and their riders, and the flesh of all men, both free and slave, both small and great."

17) The great supper was WWII and the fall of Imperialism. Birds are smaller nations that pick apart dead prey. With the fall of Imperialism, smaller governments would have stepped in to colonial lands and overtaken them or take them back.

19 And I saw the beast and the kings of the earth with their armies gathered to make war against him who was sitting on the horse and against his army. 20 And the beast was captured (seized), and with it the false prophet who in its presence had done the signs by which he deceived those who had received the mark of the beast and those who worshiped its image. These two were thrown alive into the lake of fire that burns with sulfur. 21 And the rest were slain by the sword that came from the mouth of him who was sitting on the horse, and all the birds were gorged with their flesh.

19) Here is the rise of the dragon beast and it's 10 horns, ready to make it's war with mankind. The second beast listed, in verse 20, is the earth beast of Europe and with it the false prophet beast of the USA. The earth and sea beasts were thrown alive in the lake of fire, showing that they would survive WWI and WWII. The mark and the image also make their appearance, and they are used by the dragon beast in chapter 20. The mark is the dollar, which is fiat currency, and the dragon will use the digital currency. The image is the UN and they will be the governing force to inflict the will of Mystery Babylon, the secret societies. The UN 15-minute cities will be how AI controls humanity, giving power to fallen angel technology. The signs done by the false prophet were the bombings of Hiroshima and Nagasaki, the great hailstones in chapter 13.

At the end of the Day of the Lord, the time of God's wrath, the United Nations was formed, and ratified by the U.S, fulfilling the term "gave breath to the image" in chapter 13. This image of the beast now has the power to govern the planet. The U.S. is the peacekeeping arm of the UN, and the largest contributor to the peacekeeping missions of the UN. The Korean War, Vietnam War, and many others after were the decisions of the UN. The 10 horns of the elite families had indeed given their power to the dragon. The shroud of secrecy has been lifting and those that are awake can see how the powerful governments are infiltrated by the leadership of the secret societies and the Jesuits. The most powerful governments have been consulting the vatican for decades. Here is one example I recently found which happened in the 1980s called "The Holy Alliance" - *President Ronald Reagan and Pope John Paul II engaged in a secret, high-level alliance during the 1980s, utilizing the CIA and Vatican intelligence channels to undermine Soviet influence in Eastern Europe, particularly in Poland. This collaboration, sometimes called a "Holy Alliance" of spies, involved the sharing of sensitive intelligence, covert funding for the Polish Solidarity movement, and regular clandestine briefings between CIA Director William Casey and Vatican officials.* The United States is not a sovereign beast any longer, it is run by the dragon and the 10 horns. The dragon will use the mark and the image to control civilization, which causes it to remain hidden. There will be a time when the Jesuit papacy will condemn true followers of Jesus, see Revelation 20:4. There will be a uniting concept of piety, which is a powerful religious spirit. It's the same evil that Jesus had to condemn while he walked the earth. Adherence to a set of rules can unite the Jews, Muslims and Jesuits and condemn any true followers of Jesus. The groundwork of persecution has already been laid in the USA in 1991 with the government passing Noahide Laws, which are punishable by beheading.

21) The wording of verse 20 shows there to be two lakes of fire. This lake of fire was before or simultaneous to the gorging of the birds, which was the fall of Imperialism. Imperialism ended by the time WWII was over, so the 30 years from the Spanish Flu to the end of WWII would have been a lake of fire, or a process of judgement by fire. The European beast was seized, and the United States along with it, and suffered loss of wealth, loss of life, and destruction of their property. Jesus had come like a thief to steal, kill and destroy as shown in chapter 16. This is important because there is a coming lake of fire in chapter 20 that has hardly any description. That one will be much worse because it will be the unquenchable fire, where the worm does not die...Gehenna. It's important to see how the first lake of fire affected life so we can be prepared for the second lake of fire. We also need to be prepared for the cup of wrath as shown in chapter 18. The lake of fire is the judgement of God, here it burns with sulfur which shows that there was gunfire and bombing as part of the judgement.
