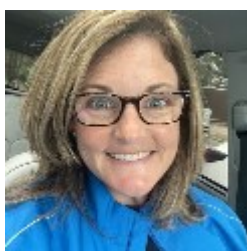

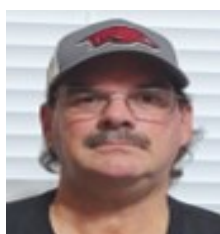

REGISTRATION & SQUADDING

Registration will begin Tuesday, June 18, at 2:00 p.m. in the Clubhouse. In the clubhouse, there will be three (3) separate registration lines: one each for Classification, Squadding, and Cashiering. Before entering the Classification line, **shooters must have their complete and up-to-date ATA Average card ready to present**, along with **proof of current ASTF/state membership**.

PRESQUAD opens April 13th

SHOOTERS ARE HIGHLY ENCOURAGED TO PRESQUAD FOR ANY/ALL EVENTS THROUGH **PRESQUAD.COM** at the rate of \$2 per post.

FEES- Cash or check. Make checks payable to ASTF.

NEW THIS YEAR: ASTF will accept credit card payments with a 3% service fee.

IRS Regulations require a Social Security Number for accumulated winnings of \$600+ may be distributed by check.

RE-SQUAD FEE

Any shooter that chooses to re-squad for reasons of *convenience* or *weather* will be charged a \$20 re-squad fee, per occurrence. No exceptions.

PRACTICE / MAKE-UP

Field #1 will be utilized for Practice and Make-ups. Although there are no immediate plans, Management reserves the right to utilize Field #1 to help finish an event, if needed.

SHOOT TIMES / PRACTICE

ALL EVENTS WILL BEGIN AT 8:00 a.m., EXCEPT FOR TUESDAY (AIM) AND SUNDAY, WHICH BEGIN AT 9:00 a.m. No shooting of any kind, on any day, prior to 8:00 a.m. **PRACTICE TICKETS** available in the Pro Shop.

AR SINGLES CHAMPIONSHIP - 200 TARGETS

Fields will not be rotated on Saturday during the Arkansas Singles Championship (Event 11). The second 100 targets will be shot on the same field as the first 100 targets.

TROPHIES

The intent of the ASTF regarding the winning of trophies: Current ATA rules apply to all trophies. Thank you for your cooperation in picking-up trophies during the week and not all at once on Sunday when everyone is rushing to go home! Trophies will NOT be mailed; arrangements may be made to pick up another shooter's trophy; see Trophy Chairman. A schedule of times when trophies may be picked up will be posted.

TARGETS & TARGET SETTING

Targets will be White Flyer All Orange targets. Flight, angles, and height will be in strict compliance with the ATA rule book. Background is a shot curtain.

100 & 200 STRAIGHT PINS

Shooters breaking 100 or 200 straight targets, without carryover, will be awarded a 100 or 200 straight pin. One pin per lifetime. Please see cashier once the event is finalized.

ASTF ANNUAL MEETING

Sunday, June 23, 8:00 – 9:00 a.m., West end of Clubhouse

Everyone is encouraged to attend but only those meeting the following criteria will be eligible to vote.

IMPORTANT VOTING CRITERIA:

Those and only those meeting the following criteria are allowed to vote. All residents who are both current ATA members (*paid 2024 ATA dues*), and ASTF life members, residing in the State of Arkansas, who are present in person at the meeting, and who have been active members registering targets in any two (2) target years, shall be entitled to vote.

ATA All American rings & Arkansas State Team awards will be presented. **Group photos** will be taken.

ZONE MEETINGS

Saturday, June 22 at 7:30 a.m. At this business meeting, All residents who are both current ATA members (*paid 2024 ATA dues*), and ASTF life members, residing in the State of Arkansas, who are present in person at the meeting, and who have been active members, registering targets in any two (2) target years, shall be entitled to vote.

Note: Shooters tied in Handicap events may elect to carry their ties only if shoot management and all shooters involved agree to carry over. This decision must be made before 3rd call.

SUNDAY MORNING CHURCH SERVICE

A non-denominational church service will start at 7:00 am Sunday morning at the West end of the Clubhouse.

MOTORIZED VEHICLES - A Permit is required.

All motorized transportation (excluding wheelchairs) must check in at the pro shop to obtain a permit. **To obtain a permit you must have a valid driver's license and proof of \$300,000 "Off Premises" Liability insurance.** The use of motorized transportation vehicles by non-shooters will not be permitted on or near the shooting fields during state shoot competition and shoot-offs. Bonafide shooters, shoot management, and shoot personnel will be permitted to use motorized transportation vehicles, provided they possess a permit, and make every effort to minimize the use of these vehicles when possible during any actual shooting competition. The policy does not apply to wheelchairs, motorized or not, which are always permitted on the grounds during the state shoot. **There will also be "Quiet Hours" this year from 10pm-6am. No side by sides, golf carts, or utility vehicles can be in use during these hours.**

SHOOT ANNOUNCEMENTS

We are using **Remind** text services to keep everyone updated on shootoffs and events. Follow these instructions to sign up:

CLASSIFICATION

Shooters are required to have both their 16-yard and Doubles averages for the current year. The Handicap Committee will classify shooters based on known ability and the following:

Shooters with the following registered target totals during the current and previous 2 years will be classified as follows:

- Less than 1,000 16-YARD targets** **Class B or higher**
- Less than 500 DOUBLES targets** **Class B or higher**

Assigned yardage applies during this shoot. Shooters with less than 1,000 total Handicap targets registered in the current and previous 2 years will be assigned penalty yardage as indicated below.

- Less than 1,000 HANDICAP targets**
 - .Adult males - 23 yards**
 - .Ladies and Juniors - 21 yards**
 - .Sub-Juniors - 20 yards**
- Senior Veterans – Assessed NO penalty Yardage or Class**

The Handicap Committee reserves the right to change the shooter’s classification at any time.

Rules

1. ATA **rules** will govern this shoot. It is the shooter's responsibility to know the ATA rules.
2. **Trophy pick-up** times will be posted in the club house. Trophies will not be mailed. **Please pickup trophies during the week.**
3. All **options** will be open. Options will close when the first squads for the event are called to the line.
4. **Special Categories**

Lady I	A Female shooter who has not reached her 55th Birthday
Lady II	A Female shooter who has reached her 55th Birthday
Sub-Junior ...	A shooter who has not reached his/her 15th Birthday
Junior	A shooter who is 15 but has not reached his/her 18th birthday
Junior Gold .	A shooter who is 18 but has not reached his/her 23rd birthday
Sub Veteran .	A shooter who is 55 but not reached his/her 65th birthday
Veteran	A shooter who is 65 but not reached his/her 70th birthday
Sr. Veteran ..	A shooter who is 70 years of age and older

Age based categories are established by the age of the shooter on the first day of the target year (Sept 1st)
5. Special categories must be **declared** at the time of Classification if he/she wishes to compete as a category shooter. Categories are: Lady I, Lady II, Sub-Junior, Junior, Junior Gold, Sub Vet, Veteran and Senior Vet. No contestant will be allowed to declare or change category after firing their first shot. Check your entry receipt!
6. Shooters may declare only **one (1) special category**. Note: Chair Shooters are exempt from this rule and will follow ATA trophy rules.
7. A shooter may not win more than **one ATA or ASTF trophy** in the same event. Exceptions to this rule are the special donated trophies such as the Hall of Fame Award. Shoot Management will follow ATA rules and guidelines in determining trophy winners.
8. Any shooter who is tied for event Champion may **shoot-off/carry-over** for the Championship trophy. If a shooter fails in the championship shoot-off/carry-over and has declared a special category at the time of classification, the shooter will fall back to the declared special category.
9. Any shooter who has declared a special category at the time of classification, and whose score qualifies/ties for any trophy in his/her declared special category, will compete for the category trophy and not for place, class, or yardage group.
10. Any special category shooter whose score does not qualify/tie for a trophy in his/her category, may compete for place, class, or yardage group trophies.
11. Should you win or tie for high class in any 16-yard or Doubles event, or should you earn yardage in any Handicap event, it shall be the **Shooters responsibility** to report to the handicap table and have their classification or yardage reviewed. Any shooter whose class or yardage is changed for any reason, shall be **considered to have been notified** when the new class or yardage is posted on the bulletin board.
12. Any shooter failing to carry out rule 11 above, or who shoots in a class or on a yardage marked higher or lower than that which is marked on their card, will be subject to disqualification and will not be eligible to share in any money division or trophies.
13. **Advances** - Winners in the preliminary Singles and Doubles events on Wednesday will not advance a class. High scores in each class in the Singles and Doubles events on Thursday will will advance a class.
14. The State Handicap Champion automatically will earn at least 1 yard.
15. A squad will not be held more than 3 minutes. Missed squad will only allow for 50 make up targets. Beyond that, shooters will be required to re-squad on a later squad for a \$20.00 Re-Squad fee. Late shooters will not be called.

16. **Scoring** - The official score sheet must always be available for shooter inspection, at all times. Any errors must be corrected before firing the first shot at the succeeding post, or in the case of the last post, before leaving the field. Any target marked "0" or any scored target not clearly marked with "7" or "X" or 0, or any scored target with both an "X" or "0" shall be scored as "LOST" by shoot management, unless the word "DEAD" is clearly printed beside it.

17. Shoot offs will begin immediately after the last event of the day. **Shoot-off contestants** will be given 3 calls, with 3 minutes of response time after each call. If a shooter does not check in after the three calls & the 9 minutes have elapsed, they will forfeit their shoot-off opportunity.

18. In the event of **withdrawal** for reasons of *convenience* or *weather*, entry fees, purse or option money will **not be refunded**. "Weather cancellation" is the only circumstance in which target and option refunds will be given. Any subevent target shot at will count toward a score.

19. No Shooter will be considered entered until entry is paid.

20. **Double check your Entry Sheet for accuracy** prior to shooting... Classification, Category, Class, Yardage, etc.

21. Each shooter who is entitled to receive money won during any event agrees that if such money is not received by them during the shoot, payment can be mailed to them by the ASTF. All added money & option money from Sunday's events will be mailed.

22. All Arkansas residents must provide proof of Arkansas State Trapshooting Federation (**ASTF**) **Life membership**.

23. Upon approaching the Classification desk, ALL shooters must present an up to date **ATA Average card** reflective of ALL scores shot & averages calculated. Submitting erroneous cards, or shooting from incorrect yardage (no matter how their card is marked), will result in disqualification, forfeiture of trophies, etc. Any violation will be reported to the ATA Executive Committee.

24. Eye and ear protection is mandatory.

25. Shoot Management & ASTF Officials reserve the right to change, alter, or modify this program in any manner deemed necessary.

26. Shoot Management & ASTF Officials reserve the right to refuse any entry & disqualify anyone who interferes with or disturbs the harmony of this shoot in any manner.

27. All decisions by the Shoot Management regarding the listed rules, or other disputes, shall be final. All decisions will be made in conformity with ATA rules, where applicable.

28. Only shooters competing on a field at that time, referees, scorers, or other shoot officials, may be on an active trap field during a registered shoot unless a safety or emergency concern arises.

29. Trapline supervisors may move squads to alternate fields to ensure all events are completed in a timely manner.

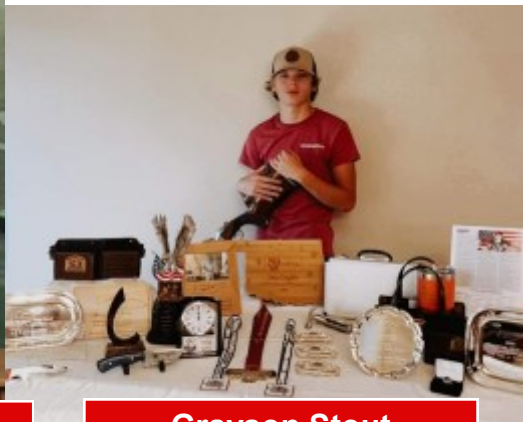

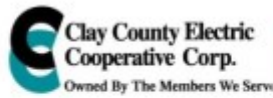

Larry Hicks was like most small town boys. He received his Daisy BB gun for his 7th birthday. The Jesup, Iowa native spent his time hunting grasshoppers and plinking tin cans. When he was eight years old, he received a 20 gauge JC Higgins. He started pheasant, rabbit and squirrel hunting with his dad. His practice was spent at a local landfill, shooting glass bottles and cans that his dad threw in the air. Larry's first experience shooting a clay target wasn't until he was 21, and then it was a hand thrown target. From there, Larry joined a local trap club and shot in spring and fall trap leagues in Oelwein, Iowa. The team he shot on, J&L Sport, was the team to beat.

Larry and his wife moved to Arkansas in 1979. He met up with Gary Phipps through work, in about 1986, and he asked him to be on his trap shooting team in Bella Vista. He started going out to JB Heads trap range in Rogers for the local

Tuesday night turkey shoots. JB Head was always there to give pointers on trapshooting. A new shooter arrived at JB Heads one night with an old Browning A5 and wanted to shoot some trap. That shooter was Mike Tucker. They became shoot buddies and good friends. The two traveled around shooting trap and making memories.

Larry's first registered shoot came in 1994 at the Arkansas Trap Shoot in Lonoke. New shooters were put in B Class with penalty yardage, and Larry ran the first 100 and broke 97 in the second round, landing a shoot off with Kurt Hayes. Kurt won the shoot off for runner up, but Larry won Novice and B Class. He was hooked on trapshooting.

Larry served as a Northern Director, Shoot Director and President of Bella Vista. He holds his NRA Shotgun Coaches Certificate. Larry dropped out of trapshooting with a back injury but was later lured back into competition shooting when a high school team asked him to come help coach. It just happened to be a 9 year endeavor with great memories.

The 2023 trap shooting season was a bucket list endeavor. Larry decided in 2022 that he was going to chase All-American points and shoot as many State and satellite shoots as possible and decided that he would shoot the whole program at the Grand. He was proud to have made the All-American Team with so many good seasoned shooters from all over the country. The best part of the 2023 season was the friendship and support he received from all the shooters.

Larry credits his wife, Kathy, who has supported and encouraged his shooting for 56 years. Larry added, "It's an honor to join such an illustrious group of shooters in the Arkansas Hall of Fame."

Eddy Kinslow's door to trapshooting opened when his days of golfing with his daughter slowed to an end. Needing a new sport to enjoy, a gentleman named Lee Grams introduced Eddy to trap following a discussion in church about his shotgun tie clasp. In 2008, Lee and Eddy found their way to the range at Bella Vista and met Sam Weaver. A new friendship and a love of trapshooting was born that day. From lessons on etiquette to pointers about welcoming new people to the sport, Sam's



mentorship lit a fire in Eddy. According to Eddy, "It takes people like Sam to welcome you to the range and get you started. Sam taught me to make people feel welcome so they will come back. Sam is still a mentor and a great friend today". Eddy explained that when he first started shooting trap, he used his field gun like most beginners; however, Gary Phipps stepped in and taught him that weight on the stock was his friend. He said that instead of selling him one of his products, he offered him advice and taught him how to offer advice to others. According to Eddy, "Gary Phipps is one of the greatest ambassadors of Trap". One of the best outcomes of a life in trapshooting has to be the friends we make along the way, and Caleb Coody and Mike Tucker certainly served that role for Eddy. He shared about the many memories made during state shoots, and about Tommy Hall telling him he needed stuff if he planned to shoot--only to tell him later he had too much stuff. The stories are too many to tell according to Eddy.

In 2012, Eddy jumped into the planning and work required for the State shoot program under newly-elected ASTF President, Chuck Sharp. According to Eddy, "Chuck had great visions for the ASTF" and he attributed teamwork as key to assembling the program. It was that year that Eddy successfully created the first ASTF website and maintained it for many years. Eddy faithfully served the ASTF program from 2012-2020. Additionally, Eddy was a member of the Bella Vista Sportsmen's Club and held the positions of secretary and shoot director and is the current President at Bella Vista.

Eddy's love for the sport and his contributions to the Arkansas State Trapshooting Federation have left a legacy that will continue to benefit shooters for many years to come. ASTF is fortunate that back in 2008, Eddy's daughter just lost interest in golf. Shooters for years will benefit from his contributions.



2004 ATA Life Member Michael Tucker has been a notable figure on the Arkansas Trap scene for nearly 30 years. A native of Manila, Arkansas, Michael (aka Mike, Tucker, or simply Tuck), started trap shooting in 1995. This introduction began by taking his son Ryan to weekly trap shoots at JB Heads' range in Rogers, Arkansas. Equipped with a Browning Auto-5 two-barrel set he received as a Christmas present from his parents, Tucker began shooting and soon found himself breaking consistent 22's or 23's on each round.

At the conclusion of the weekly trap shoot, Tucker was approached by JB. "You obviously enjoy shooting this game, but if you are going to be serious about this, you really need a trap shotgun", JB noted. Soon, Tucker purchased a pair of Beretta 390 Super Traps for him and his son, Ryan, who soon became more interested in cars and girls than the shooting sports.

With a little encouragement from local trapshooter Larry Hicks, Tucker attended his first registered shoot in 1996, the prestigious 200 Singles at the Arkansas State Shoot in Lonoke, Arkansas. "Come shoot the singles, they will put you in Novice and you will have a good time!", Larry noted. Tucker was promptly classified in B Class. The first 50 targets resulted in a 22 and a 23, then cleaning the back 50 without an issue. Nelson Adams also shot a 95 in the front. After completing the back 100 and only dropping 1, Nelson walked by Tucker and quipped, "you got to run 'em to beat me!" Heads down Tucker returned for the back 100 and earned his first 100 straight for a 195/200, winning B Class out right.

Over the next 25 years, Tucker returned to the Arkansas State shoot to claim trophies in class and categories, notably the 2012 Remington Handicap Champion. Tucker has also captured trophies in Missouri, Indiana, Louisiana as well as the Spring and Southwestern Grands, and even the ATA Grand American itself. Currently his Total Target Attainment stands at 65,175 Singles, 61,000 Handicap and 43,650 Doubles.

Many of Tucker's lifelong friends have noted his unique style of shooting doubles that was born from an ankylosing spondylitis diagnosis. He has been accused of 'skipping shot' off the trap house to break that first target faster than most people can see. This shooting style was an inspiration to many, causing one shooter in particular to note, "If he can get out there and shoot them doubles, so can I!" Several friendships have been started by simply asking Tucker, "Can you show me how you do that?". Tucker would tell them, "You just set your hold point where I break that first target".

Additionally, Tucker has been a supporter of the Bella Vista Sportsmen's Club for numerous years. He has provided trophies in the form of merchandise from his store, Tucker's Furniture and Appliances in Rogers, AR, as well as cases of shells for the youth. He has held the office of ASTF President for multiple years as well as being a financial sponsor to the Arkansas State Shoot.
