Course requirements: Each student must successfully complete the <u>PADI Online Rescue Diver Academic Course</u> requirements to become a Rescue Diver or Jr. Rescue Diver. These requirements are then built upon in confined water by personal instruction, and hands on practice. Divers must pass the Final written examination as part of their Rescue Diver Certification. Once a diver has mastered their academic requirements for the class, they must complete 10 specific rescue dive related activities in pool sessions under the direct or indirect supervision of their instructor. Divers must also demonstrate their knowledge and rescue skills by participating in and mastering 4 Open Water Rescue Scenarios. Students must be a minimum age of 12 and have instructor approval to participate in this curriculum. Instructor approval is designed to evaluate a student's maturity, physical ability, and the diving skills necessary to successfully and safely master the requirements for the Rescue Diver Certification.

As part of this curriculum, divers must achieve certifications in both a First Aid and CPR. Divers Training & Supply teaches these programs and certifies individuals in these curriculums. If a diver already holds current and valid certifications in First Aid and / or CPR, they may be applied to the requirements of the PADI Rescue Diver program and the diver may not be required to retake these programs. However, your instructor may require a student to demonstrate their abilities in both First Aid and CPR. This demonstration of an individual's expertise is necessary to qualify their certifications as being both current and proficiently applicable to specific skills required of a rescue diver and necessary for their Rescue Diver Certification.

Each diver in class is responsible for having their own equipment or renting the necessary scuba gear and exposure equipment as well as paying their own trip and destination entrance fees, tank fills, expenses associated with traveling, meals, etc. to the location for completing their Open Water Rescue Training activities.
