

CURBSIDE CLEANUP GUIDELINES (HOUSEHOLD ITEMS ONLY)

Items Included During Curbside Cleanup:

- > All Items That Are Not Stand-Alone Items Must Be Bagged:
 - Bags cannot exceed 50 lbs. each
- > Carpet: Must be cut into bundles:
 - Bundles cannot be longer than 4ft in length
 - Bundles cannot exceed 50 lbs. each
 - Bundles must be tied with string/twine
- > Furniture
- Couches, chairs, dressers, tables, bookshelves, desks, headboards, etc.
- > Glass portions of doors, windows, etc. NOTE: These must be broken and placed into a
- > All nails/staples or anything sharp that is exposed must be removed to prevent injury
- > Basketball sets/poles: NOTE: These must be broken down/cut into 4ft. sections and cannot exceed 50 lbs. per section. (please do not include concrete)

Items Not Included During Curbside Cleanup:

- > Construction debris/home remodel or demolition debris of any kind:
 - Shingles, drywall, vinyl siding, molding/trim, fencing, kitchen cabinets, etc.
- > Appliances (refrigerators, freezers, washers, dryers, dishwashers, stoves)
- > Loose trash or trash in cardboard boxes
- Air Conditioners
- Water Heaters
- > Concrete
- Any liquid form of lead/oil based paint or varnish
- Batteries
- Yard waste
- > Fluorescent light bulbs
- Any other items not listed identified as hazardous waste.
- > Electronic Waste due to IL state law, electronics cannot be disposed of in landfills and therefore cannot be placed at the curb for pickup. This includes televisions, computer monitors/accessories, and DVD/VCR players.
