ORDINANCE NO. 23-438

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 27 (“OFFENSES”), ARTICLE II (“GENERALLY”), BY ADDING SECTION 27-2-30 “PEDESTRIANS WALKING ON ROADWAY” OF THE REVISED CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE VILLAGE OF VALIER, FRANKLIN COUNTY, ILLINOIS.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Trustees of the Village of Valier, Franklin County and State of Illinois, as follows:

SECTION ONE: The Revised Code of Ordinances of the Village of Valier Chapter 27 (“Offenses”), Article II (“Generally”), is hereby amended by adding Section 27-2-30 (“Pedestrians Walking on Roadway”) to the Revised Code, which shall state the following:

27-2-30 PEDESTRIANS WALKING ON ROADWAY. Pedestrians within the Village of Valier shall be subject to the following:

(A) Any person walking along and upon the public roadway shall keep on the left of said roadway, specifically the paved portion, or the shoulder thereof, and upon meeting a vehicle while walking on said roadway, shall step off the roadway to allow the vehicles to pass.

(B) Where sidewalks are provided within the Village of Valier, it is unlawful for any pedestrian to walk along and upon an adjacent roadway, except at a crosswalk.

(C) It shall be unlawful for any pedestrian who is under the influence of intoxicating compounds or intoxicating substances to be upon any roadway of the Village of Valier.

(D) Pedestrian usage of all alleyways is prohibited within the Village of Valier after dusk.

(E) No person shall stand in a public roadway, parkway, or sidewalk for the purpose of soliciting a ride or soliciting business from the driver of any vehicle.

(F) No person shall be permitted to wear face coverings for the sole purpose of preventing identification by police officers or other authorities within the Village. However, the use of face coverings for religious purposes shall be permitted so long as the individual provides police officers and authorities with their identification.

(G) Any person walking along and upon the public roadway after dark shall wear reflective and/or bright-colored clothing, with a light, so that the individual can be seen by vehicles, police officers, and other pedestrians.

(H) Violations of subsections ((A)-(G)) of this Section shall be subject to the following fines and penalties:

- (1) 1st Offense: \$250.00
- (2) 2nd Offense: \$500.00
- (3) 3rd Offense and Subsequent Offenses: \$750.00

SECTION TWO: All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed so far as such conflict exists.

SECTION THREE: This Ordinance shall be effective from and after its due passage, approval, and publication as required by law.

SECTION FOUR: The Village Clerk is directed to publish this Ordinance in pamphlet form.
