	□ Each Representative must have his or her form. □ Either the Representative or the Candidate can arrive at the polling station 15 minutes before it opens. He or she can observe the election officers count and initial the ballots and inspect the ballots and other official papers for the poll. □ The Representative can observe and keep count as the Deputy Returning Officer counts the ballots. The Deputy Returning Officer is the only person who handles the ballots. Remember, you must always respect and not interfere with election officers. □ The Representative may disagree when the Deputy Returning Officer accepts or rejects a ballot. Tell the Deputy Returning Officer why you object. They record your objection and decide to accept or reject the ballot. The Deputy Returning Officer's decision is final. Objections will be noted in the poll book.
