## LENTEN REGULATIONS

During the season of Lent, the Church urges all the faithful to reflect a spirit of penance in their daily lives through performing acts of faith & abstinence.

- ❖ **Fasting** required one full meal be taken for the day and two smaller meals (ages 18-59);
- ❖ **Abstinence** prohibits the eating of meat on a particular day (ages 14 & older); Fridays during Lent are days of abstinence from meat;
- ❖ **Good Friday** is a day of fast & abstinence.
