<u>VISITS TO SEVEN CATHOLIC</u> CHURCHES ON HOLY THURSDAY

A recommended practice for Lent is making a pilgrimage. A Pilgrim Pamphlet Guide will be made available to parishioners on the Fifth Sunday of Lent (April 7, 2019) and on Palm Sunday (April 14, 2019) for those wishing to participate in the venerable custom of 'visiting seven churches' on Maundy (Holy) Thursday

evening, April 18, 2019, for prayer, reflection, and adoration of the Blessed Sacrament. The evening Mass time at each church in Dutchess and Ulster counties, the location of the Altar of Repose (repository), and closing time of adoration are in the pamphlet. Also included in the pamphlet are Pope Francis' prayer intentions for April 2019, and suggested scriptural prayer verses for seven churches. Pilgrims normally set out after attending the evening Mass of The Lord's Supper at their home parish; at this Mass a plenary indulgence may be gained during the solemn procession of the Blessed Sacrament to the Altar of Repose. They then go on the self-directed 'visits' to six other churches. The tradition of visiting seven churches comes down to us from St. Philip Neri in 16th century Rome; however, visiting three churches is the custom in some areas.
