Legislation designed to intimidate and silence pro-life pregnancy centers has passed through a State Senate committee and can be voted on by the full Senate at any time. The legislation is unnecessary, as it seeks to address a problem that does not exist and discriminatory as it seeks to silence all pro-life speech and actions, leaving pregnant women with only the tragic "choice" of abortion.
