Running events: 9:30 am

Multi-Events: Multi-events will not be contested. Athletes will need to register on athlete.net region 14 AAU Qualifier site.

Steeplechase, Javelin and Pole Vault will not be contested due to the facility restraints. Athletes will still need to register for their event and will automatically advance to the regional qualifier. Athletes should do this by going to athlete.net and registering directly on the region 14 AAU Qualifier site.

(turbo javelin is being contested)

Meet Sanction: The 2026 AAU Wisconsin District Qualifier will be governed under the code guidelines and follow competitive rules as outlined in the AAU Youth Athletics Handbook.

REGISTRATION

Membership: A valid 2026 AAU membership is required to participate. Visit <https://aausports.org/Join-AAU> to purchase a current membership. AAU memberships cannot be purchased at the event facility.

Entry Fee: The entry fee is \$25.00 per athlete. All fees are non-transferable and non-refundable.

Entry Deadline: Registration must be paid by credit card online at www.athletic.net. Entries must be submitted **NO LATER** than **9:00 pm WEDNESDAY, June 17th, 2026**.

Note: Athletes who are 18 years of age through the final day of the AAU Jr. Olympic Games are eligible to compete in the 17-18 age group.

Proof of Age: Proof of age may be required at the District meet and whenever required and/or challenged.

Acceptable forms of age verification include:

1. Original birth certificate
2. U.S. Military Government ID Card
3. A valid passport
4. A valid U.S. driver's License.

Event Limits: 8 & under, 9, 10, 11, and 12 - years olds: Maximum of 3 events.
13, 14, 15-16 & 17-18 years old: Maximum of 4 events.

Relay Teams: Relay teams consist of 4 members and can list up to 4 alternates.

Relays are conducted in the 8 & under, 9 & 10, 11 & 12, 13 & 14, 15 & 16, 17 & 18 divisions **ONLY**.

ATHLETES AND COACHES

Check-in: A packet will be provided for each team containing any applicable coach's wristbands, and team roster. A team representative will be responsible for picking up the packet. Packets can be picked up at the track 1 hour prior to the start of the meet.

**Awards/
Advancements:** AAU Medals will be awarded to 1st - 3rd place for individual and relay events. Top 16 in each age group and events will advance to the regional qualifier.

Equipment: Starting Blocks will be provided by meet management. All other field event athletes should bring their own personal implements. Personal blocks are not permitted.

Waivers: Athletes Scheduled to take a college entrance exam (ACT/SAT) can request a waiver from the National office. Email Proper documentation by Friday June, 1st 2025 to aaawaivers@aausports.org

Access to Track: Access to the track and infield will be reserved strictly for the meet directors, designated coaches, meet workers and competing athletes. Any parents or unauthorized individuals on the track or in the field, will result in a disqualification of their athlete or team. **THIS RULE WILL BE STRICTLY ENFORCED** and is required to keep the meet running smoothly and without Incident.
