Arrowhead PT-Timing Night Race

Join us for an exciting night of races on **Saturday, August 29, 2026** at the Mike Mulrooney Cross Country Course on the AHS Campus.

Our PT-Timing Night Race starts at dusk and finishes after sunset “under the lights!” The looped course is lined with lights, creating a unique racing opportunity that allows coaches and spectators to view at numerous points.

2026 Time Schedule:

7:25 PM - Open Race - 2.5 k (1 lap of the 2 lap course) for Grade School / Community Members - no pre-registration required - just show up at the start line - no official times kept
7:45 PM - High School Girls 5k (Fast Race - 40% of entries)
8:25 PM - High School Boys 5k (Fast Race - 40% of entries)
9:00 PM - High School Girls 5k (Faster Race - 60% of entries)
9:35 PM - High School Boys 5k (Faster Race - 60% of entries)

For the safety of the runners we will split the entries into fast and faster sections.

Please be accurate with your seed times. The faster 60% of the entries will be placed in the faster race. The cutoff time and race entry lists will be posted on PTTiming.com before Saturday.

Entry Process

Entries must be completed online via MileSplit's online entry system. Coaches should register their athletes and find the MileSplit link on the event listing at www.pttiming.com. To find the event, click "Schedule" from the top header bar. Events are listed by date. Scroll down to find the meet, and to the right will be a link to the online entries. If the event is not listed, it is likely that we have not yet received the Meet Information document yet. If you have sent the meet info and your event is still not listed within a day, email info@pttiming.com with a reminder.

Entry Deadline and Late Entry Fee

The deadline for online entries is two days prior to the meet at 11:59am Central Time, unless specific arrangements are made in advance. Entries open nine days prior to the event **ONLY IF** the meet information is emailed to PT Timing on time. Otherwise, the meet will be posted and open for entries as soon as we are able, once the meet information is received. Teams failing to meet the deadline will be charged a \$200 Late Entry Fee to reopen entries. Late Entry Fee exceptions may be made at PT Timing's discretion.

Chip Distribution & Team Rosters

When schools arrive to the meet, they will need to pickup their packet from our timer at the finish line. The packet contains bib numbers with disposable timing chips applied to the back, and safety pins. Additionally, there will be a sheet containing a team roster with the bib assignments. To avoid result errors, advise coaches to double-check their printed rosters prior to the start of the race. Corrections are much easier to make before racing begins.

Additions/Changes/Substitutions

Due to the limited number of bibs/chips our timer may have available with them on-site, we cannot always make additions other than scratch and replace. Moving athletes from one race to another (Varsity to JV, for example) is accepted and we encourage coaches to communicate these types of changes with our timer prior to the start of the first race. Please keep in mind that excessive on-site changes requires extra time and could even result in delayed start times.

Your entries need to be completed before the **registration closes at NOON on THURSDAY Aug 27**

Teams not completing their entries on time will be assessed a \$50 fine by PT-Timing, to re-open registration.

Entry for the Open / Grade School / Community Race is unlimited and open for anyone! No official times will be recorded but a running clock will be displayed. No awards. The race will officially start at 7:25 pm. Enjoy a race run at dusk and stay for the races under the lights! No pre-registration is required. Just show up to the start line!

Location Entrance and Parking:

All: Entrance to the school is from North Ave on the east side of school. Use the campus entrance at Arrowhead Drive. The Hwy K entrance will be blocked off. Please see attached map.

Buses: Teams should be dropped off by the practice soccer fields on the northwest side of north campus. Buses will be allowed to pull into that area, turn around and park in the designated areas. Please see maps attached. Buses will find plenty of room to park in the lots east or south of the north campus building. Hartbrook Strip Mall at 580 Hartbrook Drive in Hartland is just to the South and East of campus where there is ample parking, food and restrooms. Thank you for your assistance in this matter.
