The Grade School 1.58 mile - Course Map - [Here](#) - The course will be the same as the high school course but instead of doing two laps of the course, the runners will finish after the first loop.

Please fill the races as directed in order (varsity, varsity reserve and then JV) to adhere to race entry size requirements and maintain safety for each participant.

Registration closes at NOON on Thursday, Oct 1

Teams not completing their entries on time will be assessed a \$50 fine by PT-Timing, to re-open registration.

You may run 8 runners in the varsity race, 7 runners in the varsity reserve race and unlimited entries in the JV race.

Entries for the Grade School Race will be on pttiming.com as well.

No contracts will be sent for grade school participants. Entry fee for each grade school athlete is \$5 per timing chip, up to a team fee of \$80. Please make checks payable to Arrowhead High School. Location Entrance & Parking:

All: Entrance to the school is from North Ave on the east side of school. Use the campus entrance at Arrowhead Drive. The Hwy K entrance will be blocked off. Please see attached map link below. [Parking Map](#)

Buses: Teams should be dropped off by the practice soccer fields on the northwest side of north campus. Buses will be allowed to pull into that area, turn around and park in the designated areas. Please see maps in link below.
