Delegates from all across the globe gathered in St. Louis to try to come to an agreement on a way forward for our denomination with regards to human sexuality. The conference voted to accept the plan that has been labeled the Traditional Plan. It is the only plan that many view as keeping with the scriptures. They also passed a plan for local churches to disaffiliate with the United Methodist Church that allows for them to keep their property. All of these plans will go before the judicial council of the church in April to determine their constitutionality. There is a town hall meeting at Christ UMC in Mobile on the 10th. I will be attending that meeting as well as a closed clergy session the next day. After these meetings take place, I hope to be able to share more with all of you as to the impact we may face.

Tuesday the $3^{\rm rd}$, at 6pm, we will be having a Fat Tuesday pancake supper to celebrate the coming of the Lenten season. Wednesday the $4^{\rm th}$ is Ash Wednesday and we will have a rather informal ash service at 6pm. In light of Ash Wednesday, we will not have Bible Study. Further there is no choir practice on Tuesday.

On St. Patrick's Day weekend, we will be having a BBQ here at the church. My hope is to have the Boston Butts ready by lunchtime so that we may enjoy them together. If you are interested in purchasing a butt, I will need the money by Ash Wednesday. The price is \$30, and they will be an 8 to 10lb average. The idea is to provide food for the community, so I ask you to be generous in the endeavor.

We are having some really great ministry moments in the life of our church, and I encourage you to get involved. One way to get involved is through your service. Grass cutting season will soon be upon us and if you are able, we need your help. Contact




