The tradition began through the efforts of Anna Jarvis (1864–1948) with church services in Grafton, West Virginia, and Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, in honor of Anna Jarvis' own mother. In 1910, the governor of Oklahoma issued the first Mother's Day proclamation. The following year all the states did so. Congress and the Executive Office cooperated in 1913 in a national resolution establishing the second Sunday of May at Mother's Day. Show your great love, deep respect and gratitude to your mother! Do not forget her on Mother's Day nor any other day!

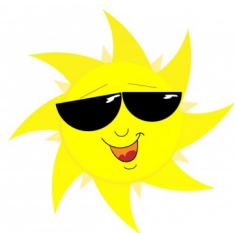

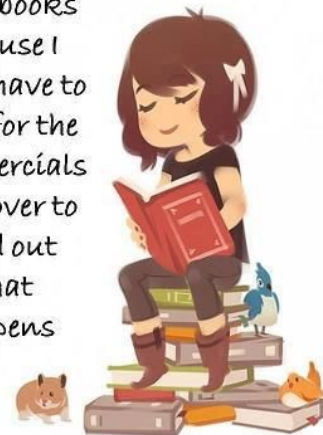
