Laura Stewart can speak to:

- How her personal experience inspired this story and why it was important to share.
- How the story reflects Catholic teachings on the dignity of every human life and God's closeness in times of sorrow.
- The central role of music in the story and the significance of music in spiritual healing and growth.
- The significance of demonstrating through the story how the family includes baby Oliver in their identity as a family, even after Oliver leaves his family for heaven.
- How too often, the medical response to a high-risk pregnancy is to abort, without fully informing women about alternative treatments that could protect both mother and child.
