The 3 Stages of Visibility

STAGE 1: The Anonymous Artist

You've got good songs, maybe even great ones but no one's hearing them.

You post occasionally, maybe a cover here, a clip there... but there's no system, no pattern your audience can latch onto.

You're in "Hope Mode" - hoping someone discovers you.

That's not strategy. That's roulette.

The Fix:

Before you post anything else, get clarity.

Who are you?

What's your story?

What's your lane?

We don't have to build a brand - we can uncover one!

STAGE 2: The Recognisable Voice

You've stopped chasing trends and started building themes.

Your audience begins to expect a certain vibe or tone.

People start recognising you before they even check your username.

You've found your thing but you're inconsistent or unsure what to post next.

The Fix:

You need structure - a weekly content rhythm and clear calls-to-action that drive engagement and growth.

We build this together inside my 3-Month Social Media Mentorship, where we design your entire ecosystem (content \rightarrow engagement \rightarrow monetisation).

STAGE 3: The Magnetic Artist

You're not chasing visibility anymore - it's chasing you.

Your posts generate conversations, duets, fan art, or local demand for gigs.

You're starting to see results: ticket sales, streaming growth, collaborations, or sync interest.

The Fix:

This stage is about refinement, scaling, and maintaining momentum.

That's where I stay by your side week-by-week - refining your tone, campaigns, and conversions so your growth becomes inevitable.

Identify your current stage and write it down.

That awareness alone will change how you approach everything you do from here.

Quick Wins You Can Do This Week

These are three low-effort, high-impact actions you can do today to start shifting your visibility:

Repost your best performer

Scroll back and find your most viewed or most commented video.

Repost it with a new caption or title.

People forget - algorithms don't.

If it worked once, it'll likely work again.

Analyse what worked about it and recreate it from different angles.

Post and observe.

Start a micro-story

Instead of saying "New song out soon!" - start a conversation:

"I wrote this after someone told me I'd never make it out of my hometown."

Stories convert strangers into fans.

Create connection, not just "content".

Comment back, ask your followers questions, and reply to DMs.

Most artists post and vanish - the winners engage like humans.

If you do these for 7 days straight, you'll start seeing signs of life.
