




Street Safety

License Plate Recognition (LPR)
 Camera on Carr Dr

- Great Crime Deterrent
- Record & Timestamp every License Plate
- Used as Evidence if Crime Occurs
- Crimes have decreased since installed
- Plan
 - Add Neighborhood Watch Sign for further deterrence
 - Continue Flock Safety \$2500
 Annual Contract
 - Seeking Parish Support





Street Safety

SPEED HUMPS

- PROBLEM: Speeding vistors, contractors, some homeowners
- Solution Suggested by Carr Drive Homeowners
- 2 Low Profile Humps (not bumps)
- Black / Yellow Rubber with Asphalt Kit 60,000 lb.
- Discussing with the Parish




