THE GOOD

- Cash Reserve Balance \$20,000
- Detailed Report Available in May after Business Taxes Submitted
- Fishing Tournaments are Profitable

THE BAD

- Firehouse Rent increased by \$100 but Rentals somewhat lower
- 2025 Income Projection Lowered from \$60K to about \$50K
- Safety & Community programs funded, but Slow Down on Major Purchases

THE UGLY

- Few Have Paid Their HOA Membership Dues
- Insurance Remains our Biggest Expense










Street Safety

Original estimates from three contractors: \$298,000 - \$358,000.

Randy Pausina, Tammy Parish Coastal Management got \$250,000 from St. Tammy Parish.

Revised costs are \$400,000 more than original estimates before Covid.

Louisiana Senator Bill Cassidy urged FEMA to reverse cuts to the state's storm protection program.

FEMA Grants & Programs Halted by DOGE While under Review, but Challenged in Courts

- Disaster Assistance
- Home Elevation
- Flood Protection Programs
- Grants to Non-profits
- FEMA Management Reorganization
- FEMA Staff Cuts

What you should know?

- Your home elevation grant application may be indefinitely delayed, or the program cancelled.
- Check your insurance and be prepared to be self sufficient after a storm.

LA Legislature Special Session on Insurance Reform

- Governor Jeff Landry says both insurance companies and plaintiffs lawyers are responsible for Louisiana's insurance rates, which are among the highest in the country.
- Commissioner Tim Temple says serious tort reform is needed to do away with bad actors and entice more carriers to write business in the state.
