## CLUB CHAMPIONSHIPS 2017

## Rules \& Regulations

1. Matches are best two out of three sets, regular scoring. A 12-point tie breaker (first to 7 , win by 2 ) to be played at six games all.
2. Master's Singles (over 60) will be played in a 'pro set' format. The first to reach 8 games determines the winner. A 12-point tie breaker to be played at 7 games all.
3. Each player/team is to bring one can of new balls to each match. Winner takes unused can and loser takes the balls played with, unless both cans were used.
4. If a player is having difficulty with contacting or getting a commitment for a date, time or location from an opponent, contact your club championship coordinator CJ [cj@sevenoakstennis.com](mailto:cj@sevenoakstennis.com) 647-6069547. Don't wait until a deadline to ask for help. One of the main duties of club championship coordinators is to quickly resolve the emergence of a frustrating situation.
5. Any match not played by the deadline in which the club championship coordinators was kept uninformed of a reasonable situation preventing the match from being played will result in a default to both players or teams.
6. In case of weather delays where a match cannot be finished the same day, play will resume exactly where it was when it ended.
7. No partner substitutions (in doubles) are allowed after the first match is played.
8. Defaults (forfeits) for a match are applied under the following circumstances: a) More than 20 minutes late to a match; b) More than 2 firmly set (date, time, location) arrangement to play broken by the same player/team against the same opponent(s); c) Cancelling a match less than 3 hrs . before its scheduled time; d) Match not played by a deadline without the coordinators being aware of and having agreed with a situation that prevented the match from being played on time; e) Inability to finish a match; f) Winner not reporting the score within 24 hrs . after a match.
9. A player who feels, during play, the presence of a chronic bad call situation or an intolerable unsportsmanlike conduct should calmly end the match and contact the coordinators who will arrange for the resumption of that match at a later date with an umpire.
