Memory Verse

Whoever conceals his transgressions will not prosper, but he who confesses and forsakes them will obtain mercy. - Proverbs 28:13

Therefore let us leave the elementary doctrine of Christ and go on to maturity, not laying again a foundation of repentance from dead works and of faith toward God, and of instruction about washings, the laying on of hands, the resurrection of the dead, and eternal judgment. - Hebrews 6:1-2

Introduction

This is the first fundamental doctrine of Christ in the scripture. Nobody can lay claim to being born again without the step of genuine repentance.

REPENTANCE FROM DEAD WORKS

• What does Repentance mean?

It is a firm conscious personal decision to change from sin (obedience to the devil) to righteousness in obedience towards God, living holy, it is not an emotion. Hebrews 6:1-2 Acts 3:19; 1Thessalonians 1:5-10.

- Repentance must involve the following steps
- ✓ Acknowledge the fact that you have sinned. Romans 3:23
- ✓ Confess your sins. I John 1:8-10. (If we confess our sins....)
- \checkmark Ask God for forgiveness and His mercy. Isa. 55:7 ,
- ✓ Ask for Divine ability to forsake your sins. Prov. 28:13;

REPENTANCE FROM DEAD WORKS

• How important is the subject to us as believers?

Genuine repentance is followed by desirable fruits of love, peace, patience faith etc. Luke 3:7-9. Jesus our Lord and master commanded us to repent and be saved. Mark 6:12, Luke 24:46-47; Peter commended it Acts 2:37-38; Paul commended it Acts 17: 30-3;

"Nobody can say he is born again without genuine repentance"

- What are the dead works from which we must repent?
- ✓ Sin Ephsians 4: 25-31
- ✓ The works of the flesh Phil3: 1-3, Gal.5:19-21 3.
- ✓ Idols 1Thes I:9
- ✓ Empty religion and all unrighteousness 2 Tim3:1-9, I Cor. 6:9-11

IDENTITY OF SIN

- •Sin is Attractive to sinners
- •Sin is not beautiful
- •Saints will need to shine light and unveil its mask. You will see what the sin is truly is
- •Sin is like vomit no matter how you make it look good as a Christian it is still vomit!

ELEMENTS OF GENUINE REPENTANCE

Conviction - Before any sinner can repent, he must be convicted that he has urgent need to make his way right With God.

Psalm 38: 4; 51: 3; Acts 2:37

Convicted means "to prove or determine to be guilty, as by the conscience".

My guilt has overwhelmed me like a burden too heavy to bear

Psalm 38: 4 (NLT)

Psalm 51:3 (NLT) For I know my transgressions, and my sin is always before me

ELEMENTS OF GENUINE REPENTANCE

Godly sorrow: This comes because of conviction by the Holy Spirit leading to repentance.

2 Cor 7:10

2 Corinthians 7:10 Godly Sorrow Worldy Sorrow

Pushes you into God's arms

Involves the whole person: Intellect, emotions, and results in life change

Has faith in the sufficiency of Jesus's sacrifice for all sins

Gives life

Rests in the grace of God

Sincerely desires to return to healthy ways of relating to God and others

Leads to eternal salvation

Causes you to hide from God

Is not integrated holistically, leading to internal dissonance

Causes you to punish yourself

Hardens the heart, leads to internal deadness

Doubts God's goodness and love

Despairs over consequences and/or realization of personal flaws and weaknesses

Leads to eternal death and destruction

2 Corinthians 7:10 (NIV)

Godly sorrow brings repentance that leads to salvation and leaves no regret, but worldly sorrow brings death.

Liking your Christian life as a home!

When you give your life to God, he is a guest!



You need to make God feel at home, that means opening and revealing all the negative and positive of yourself and life! It is an ongoing walk; it stops when we die!

REPENTANCE FROM DEAD WORKS

Reunification

True repentance involves grief and hatred for sin while turning from it to God. **Is 55:7**

Let the wicked forsake their ways, and the unrighteous their thoughts. Let them turn to the LORD, and he will have mercy on them, and to our God, for he will freely pardon.

- Isaiah 55:7

The Prodigal Son

Every time we give our life to Christ, there is a **REUNIFICATION**



REMORSE	REPENTANCE
Short-lived	Long-term
Involves emotions	Involves emotion and will
Distressed by the consequences	Distraught by his actions
Makes vague resolutions	Makes specific restitution
Wants public attention	Humbly accepts obscurity
Desires immediate return to positions of ministry/authority	Recognizes need to rebuild trust over time.
Makes external displays of contrition	Displays internal development and change
Finds fault in how he is treated in the process of discipline	Exhibits submission to the humbling process of discipline
Hesitates to follow counsel in relation to reconciliation/restitution	Initiates action toward restoring broken relationships and making restitution

REMORSE

May lead to death Comes from emotion Regret for wrongdoing Shallow and transient concern about sin. Turbulent life of sorrow and failure.

> GOD WANTS A REPENTANT HEART NOT ONLY A REMORSEFUL HEART!

Genuine Repentance vs Remorse

REPENTANCE FROM DEAD WORKS

GENUINE REPENTANCE

- \checkmark Leads to salvation.
- ✓ Comes from the Spirit.
- ✓ Godly sorrow for sin.
- \checkmark Heartfelt confession and desire to forsake sin.
- Physical manifestation of holy life, thoughts and work

REPENTANCE FROM DEAD WORKS

What are the results of genuine repentance; Psalms 51: 12-14

- ✓ Cleansing with the blood of Jesus by faith.¶ John 1: 7-9.
- ✓ Assurance of forgiveness. Rom 5: 1.
- ✓ No more condemnation thus ability to have fruitful fellowship with God in prayer. Rm 8:1.
- ✓ Justification as if sins never occurred. A new creation. II Cor 5: 17.
- ✓ Peace with God and man. Is 30:15.
- Burden of sin is lifted resulting in a time of refreshing.
 Acts 3:9.
- ✓ Joy of salvation. Psalms 51:12-14

I John 1:7-9 (NIV)

But if we walk in the light, as he is in the light, we have fellowship with one another, and the blood of Jesus, his Son, purifies us from all^[a] sin.

8 If we claim to be without sin, we deceive ourselves and the truth is not in us. 9 If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just and will forgive us our sins and purify us from all unrighteousness.

Rom 5:1 (NIV)

Therefore, since we have been justified through faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ

Rom 8:1 (NIV)

Therefore, there is now no condemnation for those who are in Christ Jesus

2 Corinthians 5:17 (NIV)

Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, the new creation has come: The old has gone, the new is here!

Psalm 51:12-14 (NIV)

12 Restore to me the joy of your salvation and grant me a willing spirit, to sustain me.

13 Then I will teach transgressors your ways, so that sinners will turn back to you.
14 Deliver me from the guilt of bloodshed, O God, you who are God my Savior, and my tongue will sing of your righteousness.
