

Greetings HMI friends, I always tell you that my chapel season has been fantastic, this season is an exception. It has been <u>ultra fantastic</u> with **9 players** coming to know the saving, forgiving, life altering, eternity assuring love of Christ! This has not been a "quick fix" for any of them, but a long series of Questions and Answers, some players weekly for three years. We have deep discussions, prayer time, and very in-depth bible studies covering just about every topic a young college student can think of. These players want to know the end game concerning following Christ and what awaits the follower of Christ. I'd like to share one of these topics with you.

As I start this newsletter it is May 14th, 2018. Today is the 70th Anniversary of Israel regaining its national identity. The world watches and waits. A long time ago, Israel started a long slide into obscurity; only 31 years after Solomon's temple was completed in 960 B.C; in 931 B.C. the nation split into the north and the south, Israel and Judah respectively, each side with a king. The nation split along governmental and religious lines; sound familiar? A civil war we might say. By 722 B.C. the Northern Kingdom falls to Assyria and 136 years later the Southern Kingdom finally succumbs to Babylon in 586 B.C. after 19 years of vicious war. So, if we say the people of Israel have been without the ownership of their nation for a long time, we could date it all the way back to the 931 B.C civil war which would be 2,948 years ago; or we could use the year 586 B.C. when Nebuchadnezzar clobbered them completely, that's only 2,604 years ago (dates courtesy Bible Historical timeline, Living Bible and New Living Translation). At any rate, on May 14th, 1948 that all changed; when the dry bones of Ezekiel Ch 37 began walking back into Israel and the generational clock of the Fig tree (a symbol of National Israel) started ticking. Jesus references this in Matthew 24:32-34. That specific generational clock of the Abrahamic Covenant is set up for the Jews in Genesis 15:13-16. Israel is alive and has their Nation back, now and forever. THE FIG TREE HAS BLOOMED! What does this mean for the world, the Jews, the Church, and the chapel ministry you support? What does this mean for those that aren't following the Jesus of the Bible? What is the impact of the U.S. having recognized Jerusalem as the Capital City of Israel against the wishes of much of the U.S. and world governments? The 70th Anniversary is extremely significant. Study Matthew 24:15. Jesus tells his disciples to refer to Daniel; Daniel 9:20-

27 especially. Then study Genesis Ch 15-17, especially 15:8-17. Then to clarify

what that covenant means, study Hebrews 6:13-20. That covenant never ends - ever! PLEASE READ AND STUDY THESE REFERENCES, don't take my word for it, please read it for yourself! I know my friend Bill Butters will, because that is what he does and who he is, thank you Bill.

This is probably the most exciting time the world has ever seen, but I'm afraid most of the world won't recognize it because they are biblically illiterate: I'm afraid many

Christians won't recognize it for the same reason. I have discussed this with many Christian friends and I'm concerned that most of them have very little clue of what awaits them... because they don't read scripture. Unless we have a **biblical worldview**; that is to balance all of the world's views and philosophies against the unchangeable word of God and all the promises and fulfilled and unfulfilled prophesies, we will be like the unsuspecting homeowner who is surprised by a thief in the night. On the other hand, his bride, the body of Christ; the ones who have long awaited him; those who know the signs of the seasons from Matthew 24 & 25, Ezekiel, Daniel, Genesis, 1 & 2 Thessalonians and Revelation...the whole bible; Jesus tells us, he will come as a friend, a welcome guest, The Bride Groom.

We can't share what we don't know! We as born-again believers have no excuse for not knowing, and to know God's word correctly, accurately and be able to put it together as Jesus showed us how.

I believe the Bible says we are in the last generation as Jesus states in Matthew 24; that means if I don't die first I will see these things come to pass; **now that gets personal!** We know the season we're in. Now if a person can muster up a phrase such as "uh oh, you're setting dates", they can be sure that they are either not reading the scriptures, don't understand what they have read, or have the same blindness the Jews had because they rejected Jesus. This is a whole new game since May 14, 2018 oops, I meant 1948.

It is comforting to know that the U.S. is once again in <u>God's blessing</u> concerning Israel, in Genesis 12:3 God says, "I will bless those who bless you and curse those who treat you with contempt." When a country stabs Israel in the back, that country is not fighting Israel but fighting God. I hope you agree, because this is also a personal blessing or curse. We have to stand with Israel nationally and personally, because what happens to Israel sets the stage and the very specific time line for the Jews as well as the church; the rapture, the tribulation, the second coming of Christ and the millennial kingdom of Christ on Earth, and finally the new heaven and new earth. Much more to come...all very good news to those of us who are awaiting his coming!!! <u>We will not be taken by surprise by our bridegroom</u> (1 Thessalonians 5:4-11)!!! **Maranatha!**

I am writing to all who have been called by God the Father, who loves you and keeps you safe in the care of Jesus Christ (NLT)." Jude 1:24, "Now all glory to God, who is able to keep you from falling away and will bring you with great joy into his glorious presence without a single fault (NLT)."
