## Fr Luke, our new Parish Priest writes:

Hello!

I thought it a good idea to offer a sort of potted biography by way of an introduction:

I am from a big family, the eldest of ten children, I was born and raised in Peterborough, Cambridgeshire. My mother's family are Catholics, originally from Malta and my father's family are Anglicans from Suffolk, (my paternal grandfather was an Anglican Vicar!) accordingly I grew up in an ecumenical environment and consider myself a spiritual 'mongrel'.

After leaving school I pursued careers in both the golf and leisure industries before discerning a call to serve God as a priest. After much prayer and reflection, I was accepted as a student for the diocese and sent to Oscott College, Birmingham, to study for the priesthood in 2004. Whilst at Oscott I earned two degrees in theology and philosophy; one from the university of Birmingham and the other from Catholic university of Leuven in Belgium. I was ordained priest on July 10<sup>th</sup>, 2010 by the late Bishop Michael Evans. Since then I have served as a prison chaplain, hospital chaplain and worked in a variety of youth and children ministries.

I have also served as an assistant priest in parishes in both Norwich and Ipswich. In 2015 I was given permission by the Bishop to work outside the diocese where I served as parish youth worker to St Augustine's Parish, Tunbridge Wells, in the Archdiocese of Southwark. During that time, I completed my Masters in Pastoral theology through Heythrop College and the university of London.

On returning to the diocese in 2017 Bishop Alan appointed me as full-time chaplain to the diocesan Youth Service and the Ignite Youth Mission Team. This last year has been very busy, as the mission team and I would spend many days a week on the road travelling across the diocese working in parishes and schools preaching the gospel to some of the youngest members of our communities. Whilst I am happy that I continue this chaplaincy role (now part-time), I am delighted that the Bishop has appointed me as your parish priest. I look forward to meeting you all, serving you and working together with you to preach the gospel of Jesus Christ and build the kingdom of God in Brandon and Mildenhall. Please bear with me whilst I find my feet in this new role!
