Diocese of East Anglia Schools Service—Volunteers for Admissions Appeals

Volunteers are being sought who wish to serve on an appeals panel, helping parents to ensure their rights are upheld in decisions relating to school places at the Catholic schools if places are not able to be offered.

The panel members play a vital role in the appeals process and the sessions could last between 20-30 minutes and are often held in the busy summer months. Volunteers might occasionally be asked to sit for two or even three consecutive days but this always relates to the flexibility and availability of the volunteer. Each panel will be made up of both lay members, people without connection to education and also those in connection with education i.e. parent governor or staff member.
