PARISH PASTORAL LEADERSHIP COMMITTEE

We are still looking for people who would like to volunteer their time in various roles for each church . It is envisaged that once a committee is established, a list of various roles will also be established to enable the community to know who the points of contact are. This will also provide a continuity reference for anyone new to the parish and anyone from the community interested in volunteering. A combined meeting of both parishes will be set for a later date so that everyone will have a chance to look at the structure and establishment of a Leadership Committee responsible for various roles in various areas.

Fr. Anil has asked for names to be added to the sheets (back of each church) for joining the parish council. Varied roles need to be filled and ideally we would like people from across both Mildenhall & Brandon, age is no barrier and we need to bring new ideas to help make us a more vibrant, thriving community. As a volunteer you will not be expected to be an expert in a specialised field, or to give up lots of time. We simply need people to create a working and meaningful parish council.

Appointment and tenure in each role will be governed by set time limits determined by the existing Diocese guidelines. Volunteers are needed for numerous areas of church/pastoral life so please sign up and state your area of interest.
