- FREE ENTRY
- No rain date
- 10x20 Space available
- NO open fire or dug pits permitted
- Any type of smoker or grill allowed
- Each team/participant is required to maintain a safe and hygienic cooking area, supply their own cooking device, cooking utensils and fire extinguisher.
- There is NO electricity or water hook-ups available, but generators are permitted.
- Vehicles are allowed ONLY to unload and load, then must be moved to parking area. The Contest area must be cleaned up and cleared by 5:00 PM. Hot coal station will be provided.

CHECK IN: 7:00 AM
START TIME: 7:30 AM
TURN-IN TIME: 2:30 PM

JUDGING – PROVIDED BY THE CADDY SHACK

- You can cook Baby Back or St Louis Style of ribs and must have 6 servings (bones) for turn in. Ribs will be inspected at check-in. Sauce should be served on the ribs, not on the side and cooked to 160 degrees. A turn-in box will be supplied. Garnish of lettuce, parsley or kale is optional but will not be judged.
- Turn-in is at the east window of the American Legion Building and within 5 minutes before and 5 minutes after the turn-in time of 2:30 PM.
- Judges will score taste, tenderness and appearance on a scale of 1 (inedible) to 10 (exceptional)
- This is strictly a friendly amateur backyard BBQ competition. Please be kind to the other contestants and respect our event.
