A sixteenth-note pattern on the snare, followed by eighth-note patterns on the hi-hat.

Two strokes on the snare drum, followed by two strokes on the hi-hat.

58

Two strokes on the snare drum, followed by two strokes on the hi-hat.

62

A sixteenth-note pattern on the snare, followed by eighth-note patterns on the hi-hat.

66

A sixteenth-note pattern on the snare, followed by eighth-note patterns on the hi-hat.
