Drum notation for measures 1-4. The pattern consists of a cross-stick on the snare (indicated by a circled 'x') followed by a single stroke on the hi-hat. This sequence repeats four times.

Drum notation for measures 5-8. The pattern continues with a cross-stick on the snare followed by a single stroke on the hi-hat, repeating four times.

Drum notation for measures 9-12. The pattern continues with a cross-stick on the snare followed by a single stroke on the hi-hat, repeating four times.

Drum notation for measures 13-16. The pattern continues with a cross-stick on the snare followed by a single stroke on the hi-hat, repeating four times.

Drum notation for measures 17-20. The pattern continues with a cross-stick on the snare followed by a single stroke on the hi-hat, repeating four times.

Drum notation for measures 21-24. The pattern continues with a cross-stick on the snare followed by a single stroke on the hi-hat, repeating four times. Measures 21-24 include a section where the snare part is marked with an asterisk (*).

Drum notation for measures 25-28. The pattern continues with a cross-stick on the snare followed by a single stroke on the hi-hat, repeating four times.

Drum notation for measures 29-32. The pattern concludes with a section that can be played in two ways:

- 1.** The snare part consists of a cross-stick followed by a single stroke on the hi-hat.
- 2.** The snare part consists of a single stroke on the snare followed by a single stroke on the hi-hat.
