### Office Monthly Activity Report of the Fire District Manager January

### **Stations**

- 1. Heat at Station 3 was an issue, reaching around 80 degrees in the live quarter. I needed PSCO controls from Syracuse to repair an automatic valve.
- 2. We received two quotes for the station repairs and are seeking directions from the commissioners.
- 3. The floor machine at Station 3 has stopped vacuuming up water. The repair company that fixes them charges \$120 per hour for travel time both ways, parts, and labor. The company is based in Rocester. We have ordered the part and will fix it in-house.

### <u>Feet</u>

- 1. The 46-1-1 light tower will not be repaired, as per the chief. The part needed for the hydraulic tank comes from J.P.B. Fire Services.
- 2. Payroll is progressing well, and Jessie has done an excellent job. However, this project has had numerous issues, primarily due to the lack of support from MicWiz Payroll and ADP Payroll.
- 3. The 46-0-4 truck is scheduled to go to the body shop on March 10. I received three quotes, all with similar time frames. Ames Brothers had the second lowest price and was the first available.
- 4. There is a truck with 46-0-3 truck stickers on it, but some are coming off. I am addressing this with the vendor.
- 5. Had to repair the station air that goes to 46-54.
