The children of St. Mark's, Grades 4 and under, are also invited to continue the tradition of our annual Mardi Gras parade by dressing up or making Mardi Gras themed "floats" to celebrate the evening. No registration is required to attend. There is suggested donation of \$5 per person or \$20 per family at the door.



Join St. Mark's as we begin the season of Lent on Ash Wednesday, March 5, with services at 7 a.m., noon, and 7 p.m. in the sanctuary. Ash Wednesday is the first of the 40 days of Lent, named for the custom of placing blessed ashes on the foreheads of worshipers at Ash Wednesday services. The ashes are a sign of penitence and a reminder of mortality, and may be imposed with the sign of the cross. Ash Wednesday is observed as a fast in the church year of the Episcopal Church.



This Lent, we return to this beautifully impactful tradition that has been a part of St. Mark's Holy Week since 2009. Music will be performed by our Music Director, Renee Rybolt, and the St. Mark's choir, with special guest musicians Ellen Story, Alaina Diehl, and more. The stations of the cross are a devotion to the Passion of Christ which recalls a series of events at the end of Jesus' life from his condemnation to his burial.
