Biography

Michelle Lander Feinberg is a contemporary artist based in Massachusetts whose compelling abstract paintings are recognized for expressive color, dynamic form, and emotional depth. She is a signature member of the [**National Association of Women Artists**](#) and an artist member of [**Galatea Fine Art**](#) and [**TAG**](#), galleries in Boston's SoWa Art and Design District. Her work has been exhibited widely in galleries, hospitals, libraries, corporate spaces, and private collections.

Her paintings are held in private collections and institutions including **Massachusetts General Hospital** and **Boston Children's Hospital**. Michelle has been featured in numerous juried exhibitions and publications. In addition to her art practice, she is a retired attorney, the author of the [*Cooper the Dog*](#) children's book series, and a mother of five.

Artist Statement

My work explores the tension between structure and intuition through vibrant color, geometric form, and abstracted landscape. Recurring circles and curves create a visual language of continuity, renewal, and ongoing growth, suggesting movement without a fixed endpoint.

Color drives the work. Used intentionally, it shapes the energy of a space, creating paintings that hold attention and invite engagement. Play is integral to my process, introducing curiosity, experimentation, and openness. This balance between intention and spontaneity reflects the nonlinear nature of experience and invites a sense of movement, possibility, and joy.

Circle Series: Renewal & Resilience

Built around recurring circular forms, the work develops a visual language of repetition and variation that is immediately recognizable.

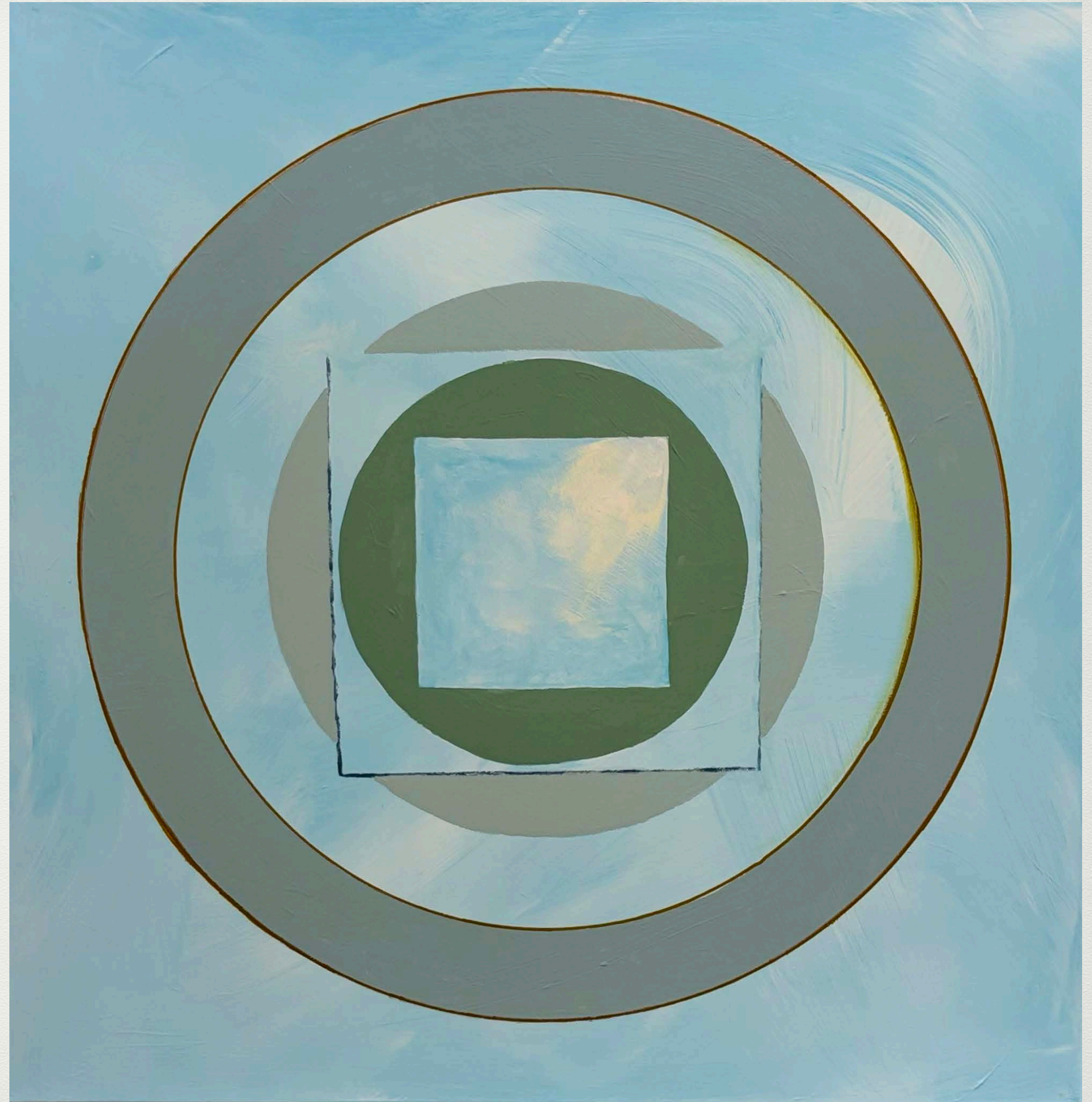

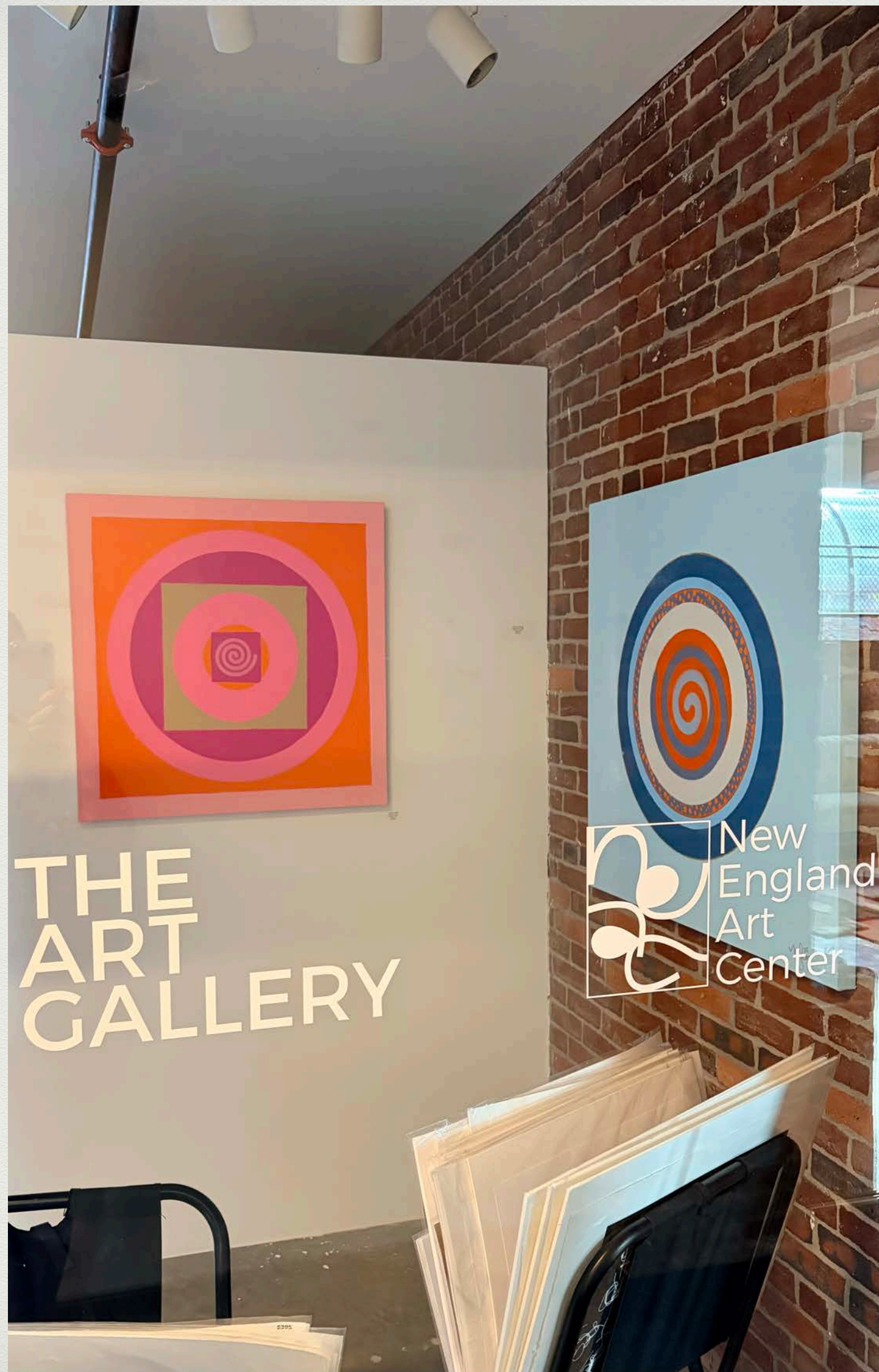

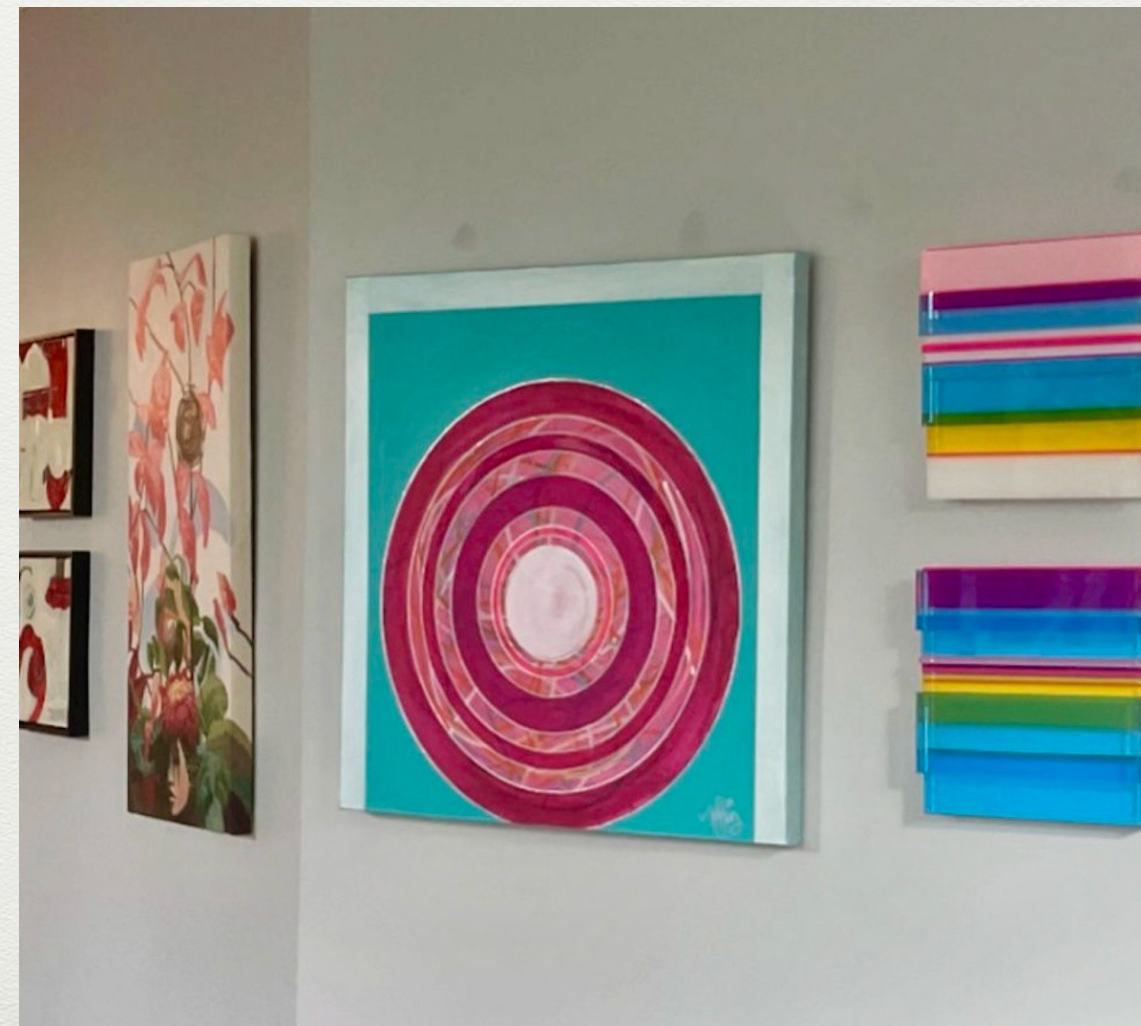
