Lily is a 3-sport athlete for the Spartans. During the tennis season, Lily was unbeaten as the #3 singles player and went on to win the County Flight 3 Championship. For her efforts she was selected to the All-Division 2 Team. In basketball, Lily was the BCIAA Player of the Year and an All-State selection. She tied for county leading scorer with 17.5 points per game. She finished her career with 41 three pointers and 1,297 points. Lily joined the track & field team for the first time as a senior and went on the win 4 medals at the District III 2A championships. She was 3<sup>rd</sup> in long jump, 6<sup>th</sup> in triple jump, 7<sup>th</sup> in high jump, and her 4 x 100 relay won the silver medal. Academically, Lily is inducted into the National Honor Society. After high school, Lily plans to attend the University of Connecticut. She is undecided on a major.
