

Drew Engle selected as Male Athlete of the Year

Twin Valley senior Drew Engle has been selected as the 2026 Spotlight On Berks Sports Male Athlete of the Year.

In the fall, Engle was the main cog on the Raiders football ground attack that led the team to the PIAA 4A Championship game. Drew carried the ball 224 times for 2095 yards and 32 touchdowns. He also caught 7 passes for 61 yards and another touchdown. For his efforts, he was selected as the BCIAA Player of the Year. In his career, Engle carried the ball 435 times for 4024 yards and 50 touchdowns. Out of the backfield, he caught 26 passes for 309 yards and 3 touchdowns.

In the spring, Engle was part of another high-powered offense. This time it was the lacrosse team where he currently has 72 goals and contributed 20 assists. For his efforts, he was selected as the BCIAA Player of the Year for the second consecutive year. The Raiders will continue their season on Tuesday in the PIAA 2A Semifinals. So far in his career, Engle scored 215 goals and contributed 79 assists.

Engle will be continuing his academic and lacrosse careers at the United States Military Academy West Point.
