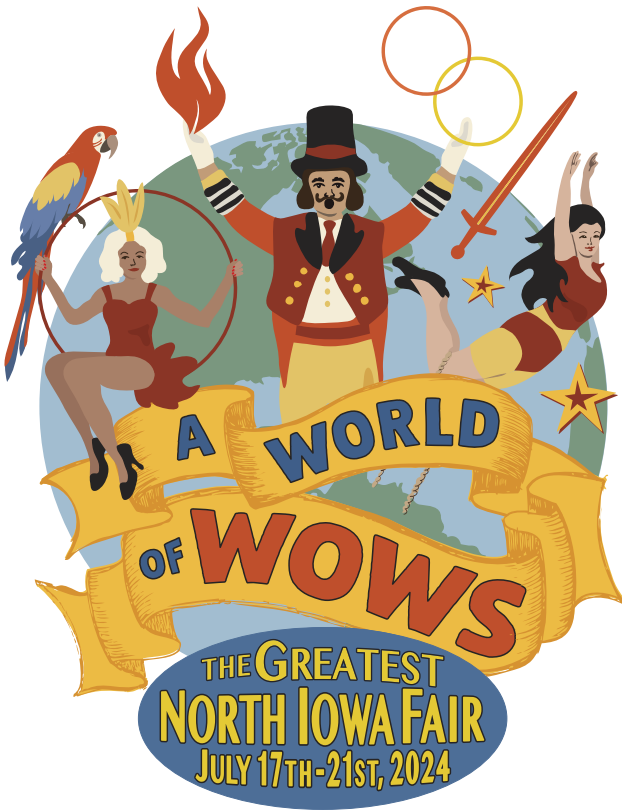

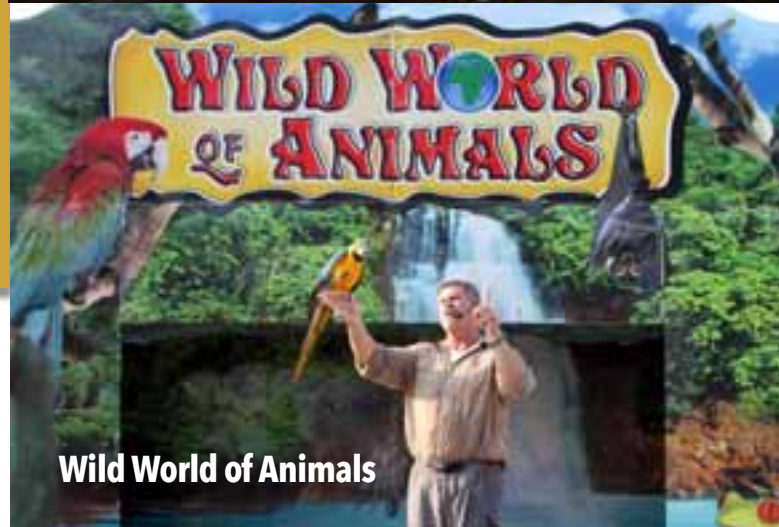

2024 INDIVIDUAL OF THE YEAR IRMA FOELL



I became involved with the North Iowa Fair back when I was old enough to join 4-H. The name of our club was "The Owen Farmerettes" and my leader was Dorothy Curran. We took turns going to each other's homes for our meetings. We had record books to fill out our different achievements - from sewing, cooking, canning and entertaining. I especially remember making pies and homemade angel food cakes, entering them and always hoping for a blue ribbon. One year, my friend Ruth Kelck and myself had a demonstration called "Make It With Cheese".

I stayed involved with my Country School, Owen #3, as it was the last rural school to close in 1958. In order to never forget our memories, a farmer named Leigh Curran, who was the president of the North Iowa Fair, purchased the school and gave it to the North Iowa Fair Association, in order to preserve the memories of the one room schoolhouse. Over the last 35 years our school has been open during the fair. We had a committee who cleaned, decorated and worked very hard to make it special for all who came in to share our school and all the memories it had to offer. The last day of the fair we would honor a country school teacher. We always had entertainment and a time for each teacher to share their memories of when they taught. It was always followed by pie and ice cream.

Years back we had over twenty teachers that participated. Just two years ago, we lost our last teacher, but we have continued to keep our school open and each day we have given away a flag after a drawing that takes place at the end of the day. Fleet Farm has donated the flags to us. We would really welcome volunteers to help us keep Owen #3 always ready to our visitors. I would like to offer a big thank you to Scott Asche for fixing our bell. The kids love getting to ring the bell. I'm just thankful to God each and every day for the strength He gives me as I try to help keep memories alive at Owen #3 at The North Iowa Fair.

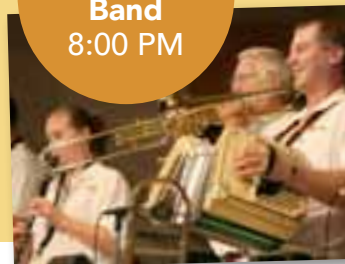

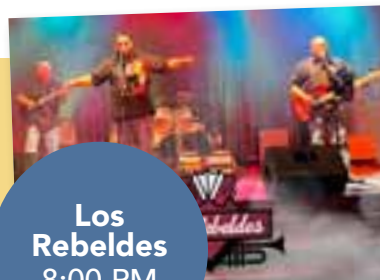
