VENDOR REGULATIONS

- A) Vendors are required to bring their own weather protection, tables, and chairs.
- B) Food Vendors required to provide proof of Liability Insurance & health /safety permits if applicable to Vendors Chair before event date.
- C) A Certificate of Liability Insurance, (minimum \$1,000,000.) to be in force during event, with "Greater Moncton Scottish Assn." named as Additional Insured. **Copy must accompany vendor application.**
- D) Temporary electrical services will be available. However, the Games committee can only guarantee one (1) 15 amp, 120 volt outlet per vendor. If you require additional power, it will be necessary for you to contact the Games representative to make the necessary arrangements at your cost, or provide your own generator.
- E) Potable Water is to be provided by the vendor for their own use.
- F) Admission to the Games site will be by ticket only. **Two tickets** will be provided to you as part of your Registration Fee. Additional tickets can be purchased at the Admission Gate.
- F) Concessions may be set up on site **after 3:00 PM** on Friday, June 14th. Security will be provided. However, the Games committee will not be liable for any loss or damages that may occur.
- G) Vehicles will only be permitted access to the site until 8:00 AM Saturday, and after approx. 6:00 PM, (or 15 min after closing ceremonies, whichever is later). Should you require your vehicle parked on field during the games, please advise such (with reason) on your vendor application.
- H) Concessions must be on the field by 8:00 AM and all vendors should be open by 9:00 AM. All concessions to remain open until after the closing ceremonies, at approximately 6:00 PM. Vehicles will not be permitted access to the field until 6:00 PM, or FIFTEEN (15) minutes **after** closing ceremonies are completed (whichever is later). Vendors are responsible for the disposal of all garbage in designated containers, and are to keep their concessions neat and tidy at all times. Failure to do so may result in being refused future entry.
- I) Health and Fire Safety inspectors may be on site before & during the event, and have the authority to close concessions if standards are not met (including fire extinguishers where cooking). The Games Committee will not be responsible for any resulting loss of revenue to any vendor, and refunds will not be provided. Any Food Safety Permits, licenses etc. are the responsibility of individual vendors and must be available upon request. **ALL FOOD VENDORS MUST SUBMIT A COPY OF CURRENT PROVINCIAL GOVERNMENT-ISSUED FOOD VENDOR LICENSE WITH THIS APPLICATION.**
