With a surprisingly easy system for learning how to do a series of moves, and a confidence-building practice regimen, Beginning Ballroom really gave us the tools and the attitude we needed to wow our guests. I don't remember the last time I even remembered a first dance; our dance, on the other hand, had the crowd actively gasping, cheering, and singing along. I think in my most aggressively optimistic dreams, I always pictured polite amusement and a vague feeling of "that was nice;" instead, what we got was several unsolicited "that was amazing!" or "wow, you know how to dance!" comments. Altogether, we obviously couldn't have done this without them, and for the extremely reasonable price tag and honestly fun lessons, I would highly recommend them!
