

## QUESTIONS TO ASK A REIKI TEACHER (and my answers)

### **How long have you been working with Reiki? What training have you had?**

I began my Reiki journey in 2014, training under Terry Rogers, founder and director of the Gainesville Center for Reiki, where I completed my first-, second-, and third-degree training in the system of Usui Shiki Ryoho Reiki. In 2015, I was certified as a Reiki Master Teacher under Cindy Zsolnai, PhD. My Shihan training with Rogers Sensei included a dedicated apprenticeship from 2016 to 2018. In 2021, I studied with William Lee Rand and earned certification as a Holy Fire® III Karuna Reiki® Master and registered teacher in that system. That same year, I received a Master Teacher attunement to Kundalini Reiki Millennium from its founder, Ole Gabrielsen. In 2022, I further expanded my practice by training in SARA's Animal Reiki for Reiki Practitioners.

Beyond formal training, my growth as a Reiki practitioner has been deeply enriched through ongoing self-study, practice, and embracing Reiki as a way of life. I am also approved as a continuing education provider through NCBTMB and the Florida Board of Massage Therapy.

**How often do you teach?** I teach group first- and second-degree Usui Shiki Ryoho Reiki classes on a regularly scheduled basis, as well as private and special group classes. These include both traditional classes and professional continuing education classes for licensed massage therapists. Master training is offered on an individual basis.

**How do you personally use Reiki?** Reiki is a focal point of my existence. I practice self-treatments daily as a method of promoting and maintaining energetic, emotional, and physical health, balance, and well-being. Family and friends request treatments from me on a regular basis. Since I am a licensed massage therapist in the state of Florida, I provide Reiki treatments for clients who request it. (In the state of Florida, you must have an LMT license or other qualifying state-regulated professional license in order to practice Reiki professionally.)

I volunteer for an international distant healing organization, which was established in 1996; and, in that capacity I have served as a group leader and volunteer, working with other volunteers to coordinate and facilitate healing requests from all over the world, including long-term distant healing requests, weekly healing requests, and healing requests for pets and animals.

As well, I stay current on the latest in clinical and academic research regarding Reiki. I network with various leaders in the Reiki community. I seek out continuing education opportunities for myself. I am also a member of various social media groups dedicated to Reiki. And, of course, I practice and teach Reiki!

## What is your lineage?

My lineage in Usui Shiki Ryoho is that of:

Usui / Hayashi / Takata / Samdahl / Lazonby / Rogers

This is an important piece of information for you to consider, as this will become a lineage available to you as well if you choose to study Reiki with me. The concept of lineage is not always understood in Western culture; and, in my classes I explain this

aspect of Reiki in depth, so that you will have a clear understanding and great appreciation for this honorable line.

As stated above, I am also a registered Holy Fire® III Karuna Reiki® Master – practitioner and teacher and Kundalini Reiki Millennium Master Teacher.

## Will this training initiate me into, or progress me within the Usui lineage?

Yes! Classes offered in the lineage of Usui Shiki Ryoho initiate you into the Usui lineage. See above for the exact chain of teachers. In the system of Holy Fire® III Karuna Reiki® students are required to have already attained the level of Reiki Master in any style or lineage. In the system of Kundalini Reiki, it is also suggested that the student have reached the level of Reiki Master in any style or lineage.

## What qualifications are required to take Usui Shiki Ryoho Reiki training?

For all classes, students must be 21 years of age or older.

First degree (Shoden) prerequisites:

1. Your willingness and desire to learn about Reiki.

Second degree (Okuden) prerequisites:

1. Your willingness and desire to further your Reiki practice and studies.
2. Successful completion of first-degree Reiki training. If you have completed your first degree with another teacher, a copy of your certificate and a short interview will be required.
3. It is highly recommended that you allow a minimum of 21 days after receiving your first degree attunements before obtaining your second degree attunements.

Third-degree (Shinpiden)

1. Ability to demonstrate proficiency in practice and understanding of spiritual
2. Successful completion of in-person Usui Shiki Ryoho Reiki first- and second-degree training. If you have completed first and/or second degrees with another teacher, a copy of your certificates and a short interview will be required.
3. Candidates for this training must sit for an interview to discuss their practice and determine the subjects comprising your individual course of study.

**What do you cover in your Usui Shiki Ryoho classes? How many hours of class time is included? How much time is instructional, and how much is hands-on practice? What are the specific things I will be able to do after taking the training? What are your fees, and will I receive a certificate and a manual?**

**FIRST DEGREE (SHODEN):** The first-degree class is a one-day event, generally lasting from 9:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. Approximately 50% of the class time is instructional and 50% is hands-on training and practice.

The benefits you will receive in this all-day, in person, first-degree class include:

- \* You will gain a general understanding and be able to explain the origins of Reiki, the different degrees of Reiki training, and the different lineages associated with Reiki.
- \* You will gain an understanding and be able to explain how Reiki differs from other energetic modalities.
- \* You will gain an understanding and knowledge of the teachers who make up your lineage in Usui Shiki Ryoho.
- \* You will become attuned to Reiki energy through multiple attunements and be able to feel Reiki flowing from your hands.
- \* You will learn the system of Usui Shiki Ryoho Reiki, its structure, precepts, and techniques appropriate for first-degree practice.
- \* You will be able to perform Reiki treatments on yourself, as well as others.
- \* You will learn different hands-on techniques appropriate to first-degree Reiki, as well as exercises from the Japanese Usui Reiki Ryoho lineage.
- \* You will learn ethical considerations in your Reiki first-degree practice.
- \* Along with a comprehensive class manual, you will receive a textbook and a Class Resources guide with multiple additional study material links and recommendations. Upon successful completion, you will be awarded a certificate of completion as a Reiki First-Degree/Shoden level practitioner in the style of Usui Shiki Ryoho Reiki.
- \* You will receive after-class support from me as needed to assist you in using Reiki to aid you in your efforts to attain peace, happiness, and joy; improve your health, state of mind, spiritual growth; and make Reiki a part of your life.

You will become eligible, at no additional charge, to audit future classes that you have successfully completed.

Tuition for regularly scheduled Reiki first degree classes is \$175.00 for the traditional class and \$225.00 for the CE class, which also provides 8 hours of continuing education for LMTs. (Additional charges may apply for individual/private classes and/or special group classes. Please call for further information on rates and availability.)

**SECOND DEGREE (Okuden):** The second-degree class is a one-day event, generally lasting from 9:00 a.m. to 5:30 p.m. Approximately 40% of the class time is instructional and 60% is hands-on training and practice.

The benefits you will receive from this second-degree, live, in-person class include:

- \* A review of Reiki first degree practices and experiences, as well as a review of Reiki history.
- \* You will learn about past and present prominent figures in Reiki, both in the United States and throughout the world.
- \* You will gain an understanding of the differences between first and second degrees of Reiki.
- \* You will learn 3 Reiki symbols, including how the symbols came to be, the meaning of each symbol, how to draw them, how to pronounce the names for each symbol, and how to apply and use the symbols in your practice.
- \* You will receive additional Reiki attunements, which will substantially enhance and strengthen your ability to flow Reiki energy.
- \* You will learn hands-on second-degree techniques for healing yourself and others, including applications for achieving goals, emotional healing of past events, healing addictions, overcoming fear and other negative emotions, and more.
- \* You will learn distance healing techniques appropriate for second degree to be able to send healing to yourself and others at a distance, including past, present, and future.
- \* You will learn ethical considerations in your Reiki second degree practice.
- \* Along with a comprehensive class manual, you will receive a textbook and a Class Resources guide with multiple additional study material links and recommendations. Upon successful completion, you will be awarded a certificate of completion as a Reiki Second-Degree/Okuden level practitioner in the style of Usui Shiki Ryoho Reiki.
- \* You will receive after-class support from me as needed to assist you in using Reiki to aid you in your efforts to attain peace, happiness, and joy; improve your health, state of mind, spiritual growth; and make Reiki a part of your life.

You will become eligible, at no additional charge, to audit future classes that you have successfully completed.

Tuition for regularly scheduled Reiki second degree classes is \$175.00. (Additional charges may apply for individual/private classes and/or special group classes. Please call for further information on rates and availability.)

**Can I take notes and tape record the class?** I absolutely encourage note taking in class if that is a process that serves your personal learning style. I do not allow classes to be recorded or videotaped for reasons of preserving the confidentiality of all participants, the distraction it would cause, and because I would have no control over how the information is used outside of the class.

**How many symbols will I learn?** No symbols are taught in Reiki first-degree classes. Three symbols are taught in Reiki second-degree. One symbol is given in Master training.

**Is there a Reiki support group in my area or can you help me establish one? Will you openly support me in being a successful Reiki practitioner or master?** There are always ways to connect with other Reiki practitioners and groups, limited only by your personal motivation and desire to establish those connections. Your class materials will include information on different groups and organizations associated with Reiki. As your teacher, I will be available to offer support and guidance to you. I am always interested in facilitating and supporting Reiki Share groups as well. I also offer my graduate students the opportunity to audit a future class at no additional charge. And, I offer private mentoring sessions.

**Do you have a positive respectful attitude toward other Reiki practitioners and masters, regardless of lineage or affiliation?** Absolutely. We are so blessed to live in a time where communication with others all across the globe is so easy. As stated above, I have trained in multiple systems of Reiki.
