This dispute is essentially over voting rights tied to Spicewood Airport. The

current Board members find themselves before the Court by virtue of their position on the Board of a 501c3 and the presumption afforded under Texas Statutes was not overcome by fraud or ultra vires acts. The Motion for Summary Judgment on behalf of the Board of Directors is GRANTED and the suit DISMISSED WITHOUT PREJUDICE.


