As you know we have now completely settled our suit with Xerox. This settlement is going to allow Charlyne and me much more freedom to enjoy life. With that thinking, I have decided that I do not want to be a candidate for the BOD for the WOWSC. In the paragraphs below I will share some thoughts as to why I reached this decision.

It is my personal opinion that there are a number of improper goings on with the operation under the current BOD and possibly past members. The Bylaws are written such that the board can do as it wants, and is, or has, operated outside legal statutes. As I see it, they are strongly against change and are complacent concerning operational effectiveness and performance.
