RE: Request for Open Records Decision – Windermere Oaks WSC.

Attorney General Paxton:

This firm represents Windermere Oaks Water Supply Corporation ("Windermere"). Windermere is a nonprofit, member owned, and member-controlled water supply corporation incorporated under Chapter 67 of the Texas Water Code. Windermere received a written request for information ("Request") under the Texas Public Information Act ("Act") from Danny Flunker ("Requestor") on November 20, 2024.

Pursuant to Section 552.301 of the Act, a governmental body in receipt of a request under the Act that it wishes to withhold from disclosure and considers to fall under one or more exceptions must request a ruling from the Attorney General not later than the 10th business day after the date of receiving the written request. The Act defines a "business day" as a day other than (1) a Saturday or Sunday; (2) a national holiday under Section 662.003(a) of the Government Code; or (3) a state holiday under Section 662.003(b). Tex. Gov't Code § 552.0031(a). Excluding Saturdays, Sundays, Thanksgiving Day, and the Friday after Thanksgiving Day, Windermere's request for a ruling is timely. *Id.* at § 662.003(a),(b).

Windermere believes that the Request seeks information that is exempt from public disclosure under §§ 552.101, 552.104, 552.105, and 552.107 of the Act. Windermere will provide the information required by Section 552.301(e) of the Act within the time permitted, and the Requestor will be provided with a copy of this letter.
