



## **Bullseye Shooting & Advanced Pistol Marksmanship Clinic**

***Saturday June 13, 2026***

***9:00AM to 1:00PM***

**Clinic Summary:** This class will provide pistol marksmanship training beyond that which is provided in an NRA Basic Pistol Course. It will introduce pistol shooters to the course of fire and rules for NRA precision pistol “bullseye” competition. It will also prepare participants for the summer pistol league. Classroom instruction will be followed by live-fire practice.

**Prerequisites:** Participants should have completed an NRA Basic Pistol Course, or have equivalent experience shooting pistols. This is not a class for new pistol owners. The participant must bring a safe pistol and 60 rounds of ammunition. Any caliber is allowed, however .22 caliber is preferred. No magnum loads are allowed. The minimum age is 16 (minors must be accompanied by a parent).

**Date / Time:** Saturday June 13th, 2026 9:00AM to 1:00PM. Meet in the clubhouse.

**Location:** Paul Bunyan Rifle & Sportsman’s Club, 17902 Meridian E, Puyallup, WA 98375.

**Cost:** This is a free training class. Class size is limited to 22 participants.

**Registration:** **Advance registration is required.** E-mail your request to Dennis at the email listed below. Please include following information: Name, phone number, shooting experience, and model & caliber of the pistol you plan to bring.

**Rules:** PBRSC safety rules will govern. No live ammunition is allowed in the classroom.

### **Things to bring:**

- Eye glasses. Bring all your glasses! Reading, computer, old (weaker) reading, distance.
- Pen and paper to take notes.
- Dress for the weather, as at least two hours will be spent outdoors on the pistol range.
- Eye and Hearing Protection
- Any safe pistol (22 to 45 caliber) with 2 magazines for semi-automatic pistols. No magnums.
- 60 rounds of ammunition.
- Spotting scope or binoculars – recommended but not mandatory.
- Stapler and masking tape (beige colored).

**Food:** Bring water and snacks as needed.
