**2021 Spring Rifle Fun League
(A two gun league, 22LR-Rimfire and Centerfire)**

Dates: May 12 to June 30 - Wednesday afternoon / evenings

Time: 3:00 pm, 4:00 pm & 5:00 pm relays

Eligibility: Open to all shooters. PBRSC membership is not required, but is encouraged.

League Fee: \$20.00 (\$18.30 + \$1.70 tax) Pay at the first league night, prior to shooting your first relay

Course of Fire:

- Benchrest: 15 minutes for unlimited sighting shots on a sighter target and 10 shots for record.
- Standing: 10 shots in 10 minutes (no support).
- Alternating weeks, we will shoot 22LR rifles at 100 yards, then centerfire rifles at 200 yards, starting with .22LR / 100 yards on May 12th.
- Up to 4 scores may be submitted each for each gun (.22LR and Centerfire). The top three each will count for place awards. After all 8 scores are fired, league participants may shoot for practice.
- More than one relay for record may be shot in an evening, as space allows.

Rules:

- 22LR rimfire rifles will be shot at 100yds, and centerfire rifles will be shot at 200 yards.
- Targets will be scored by competitors. If more than 10 shots are found on the record target, the lowest value ten shots will be scored.
- Competitors using 30 caliber service rifles with iron sights (front post) at 200 yards may use the SR target for benchrest.
- Competitors may place "shoot-n-see" targets or light colored paper on the bullseye to aid in seeing shots through a spotting scope. These will be removed for scoring. *Please bring your own.*
- Only one round will loaded in the gun at a time while shooting standing. Up to 5 rounds may be loaded when shooting from the bench.
- Shooting coats and gloves will be allowed. Slings are NOT allowed.
- You can use a different rifle each relay, but the same rifle & scope must be used for both stages of a relay.
- Calibers allowed: Centerfire, 22 to 30 caliber (222, 223, 243, 270, 308, 30-06, 6mm, 7mm, for example, are OK).
- No short barreled rifles. Barrels must be at least 16".
- No muzzle brakes or compensators will be allowed, due to muzzle blast & noise considerations.
- Note: since this is a fun league, we may modify these rules as necessary, based on participant consensus.

Squading: Competitors will be assigned to relays on a first come-first serve basis. Advanced reservations recommended; specify relay when registering.

Awards: Awards will be presented to the top competitors in each category.
