MARCH MEETING NOTES

Once again, the general meeting was cancelled due to the COVID-19 restrictions. We did hold a combination on-site/virtual board of directors meeting. We will start holding general meetings when the restrictions have eased a bit. We will put an announcement in the BullSheet when we can resume our general meetings.

We are now in the busy time of the year for the range. This month we have several matches and the annual YHEC event impacting general membership use of the range, especially the rifle range. Please check the [online calendar](#) for the latest range availability before you come out to the range.

With the relaxation of the COVID restrictions, we will be replacing the pistol range bench tops that were removed almost a year ago to provide the required social distancing. With the benchtops in place, we are still providing plenty of distancing especially for an outdoor setting. The mask, bench wiping and social distancing requirements are still in place as well as the two guest per member limit. The board will be addressing the two-guest limit at the next board meeting.

Bill Montgomery will be hosting the annual Youth Hunter Education Challenge (YHEC) Saturday April 17th starting at 7am. Since the event is held mostly outside, we will be well within the phase 3 COVID restrictions. All ranges will be closed while this event is taking place. DUES AND INITIATION FEE INCREASES

After much discussion at previous board meetings, the board voted at the November meeting to increase the annual membership dues and the one-time new member initiation fees. For the past few years, the club has operated in the red. With prices of everything going up and the impact of the COVID restrictions on the range, the board felt it necessary to increase our fees, something we haven't done in many years.

Effective September 1, 2021, the annual membership dues will be increased to \$120. Existing 2020 members who have not yet renewed for 2021 will have the option of extending their membership, for up to 3 years, at the old \$96/year rate if the renewal is received by April 30, 2021. Those who have already renewed for 2021 will have the option to renew for up to 2 additional years at the existing rate if the renewal is received by April 30, 2021.

Effective as of January 2021, the one-time initiation fee for new members will increase to \$150 and the annual dues for new members will be \$120.

LADIES SHOOTING LEAGUE

Both Girlz Nite Out (First Weds of the Month) and T-Time (Third Sundays) members practiced target drills with their pistols. A Zombie Squirrel target was introduced as a modified F.A.S.T. (Fundamentals, Accuracy, and Speed Test) where the emphasis is on accuracy. The ladies were able to reinforce re-loading skills and getting back on target. Each event includes a fun training target where different marksmanship skills are practiced.

At the end the month we have a team heading to Whitewright, Texas for an IDPA Ladies Only Championship. Hosted by Mission 160, this will be the gals first major match of the season. There are plans to once again compete in IDPA's, The Southern Belle, in October in Guntown, MS.

The Pew-pew challenge for 2020 wrapped up and 1st and 2nd prizes were awarded to members who released the most "pews" for the year. Each year tracking sheets are given to attendees to record their ammo usage. If 1200 or more bullets – or as we like to say "pew-pews) are freed, a morale patch is earned. This year first place went to Carrie with over 13,400 pews freed; 2nd place went to Jacquelyn with over 7100. There's still plenty of time to start the 2021 Challenge.

Paul Bunyan will be hosting Washington State's IDPA Championship in June. We expect a dozen members to compete in this match. In addition to competing, we will support the match by staffing critical positions such as RSOing and administrative work. ACTION SHOOTING INTERNATIONAL (ASI)

What better way to celebrate the upcoming spring than by participating at Paul Bunyan's ASI match in March! 50 shooters eager to try out wintered pistols showed up and shot 6 fun stages. Stages titled "Get to Cover", "Shady Dog Walker" or "BBQ" finds the participant shooting an array of targets from behind cover, walking (or running, if preferred) to a point of cover or picking up the gun from a table start. All stages are designed by the ASI Design Team and are purposely simple for those new to move and shoot sports.

If you are interested in learning more about our sport – attend a match! New shooters are squadded with experienced participants. If you have safe gun handling skills, a pistol caliber of .22 to .45; a bag or gun case and 2 boxes of ammo, you can join us! Most shooters have at least 2 re-loading devices – but if you have one, we can work with that. All stages are 12 rounds or less. One aspect of ASI is the emphasis on safety and the role of the Range Officer (RO), as a mentor, willing to advise and answer questions.

New Shooter Orientation is at 9 am in Bay 1 as is required for those who are new to ASI and Paul Bunyan. Pre-registration is required on [Practiscore](#) under ASI at Paul Bunyan.

SPRING RIFLE FUN LEAGUE

PBRSC will host a two-gun fun rifle league (.22 LR-Rimfire and Centerfire) beginning Wednesday May 12 through June 30; 8 weeks to fire 6 scores. Up to 4 scores may be fired with each gun, with the top three for each used for aggregate score. .22 LR will be fired at 100 yards and centerfire at 200 yards from both the bench and standing positions.
