



Beginning Pistol Shooting Course

The beginning Pistol Shooting Course is taught by NRA Certified Instructors and will cover the basics of safe and proper gun handling and pistol shooting. Participants will learn about firearm safety, parts and operation, shooting fundamentals, care and cleaning, storage options, selection, and more. BEGINNING PISTOL SHOOTING COURSE SYLLABUS

Course Length: Total Class and Range time is a minimum of eight hours, but it may go longer. The class is scheduled for 9:00 AM to 4:00 PM both days.

Course Goals: To teach the basic knowledge, skills, and attitude necessary for owning and using a pistol safely

Course Lessons:

Lesson 1 - Pistol Knowledge and Safe Gun Handling

Lesson 2 - Ammunition Knowledge and the Fundamentals of Pistol Shooting
Lesson 3 - Firing the First Shots
Lesson 4 - Scoring Targets, and Selecting and Maintaining a Pistol
Lesson 5 - Continued Opportunities for Skill Development

What to Bring: A safe attitude; eye and ear protection if you have them. Bring your lunch, snacks and drinks. Students may bring their own pistol, either revolver or semi-auto and 50 rounds of factory new ammunition (light target loads, NO reloads, magnums or +P). Dress comfortably and be prepared for both indoors and outdoors (you will be outdoors on the covered range for approx 4 hours).

What we will provide: A 22 caliber revolver, 22 caliber semi-automatic pistol and 22 caliber ammo; eye and ear protection; targets; enthusiasm; and a safe learning environment. A certificate of completion will be provided to each student who successfully completes the course.
