53rd ANNUAL RIFLE MATCH

Saturday, September 5, Sunday, September 6 & Monday, September7, 2020

LOCATION: Paul Bunyan Rifle & Sportsman's Club Range, 17902 Meridian E (WA State Hwy. 161), - 6.5 miles south of Puyallup, Washington. From I-5 take exit 127 and follow Hwy. 512 to the Canyon Road exit. Turn right onto Canyon Rd. Turn left at 176th for approximately 6 miles. Turn right onto Meridian. The range is on the right.

STARTING TIME: Registration 7:30 - 8:30 AM each day. Firing starts at 9:00 AM each day.

ADVANCE ENTRY: Advance entry and banquet registration are requested. <u>ADVANCE BBQ REGISTRATION</u> is needed so that enough food can be provided. **Competitors wishing to hire a target puller must state so BOTH on their advance entry AND when registering at the Stat Office.**

- ENTRY FEES:ONE Day Only\$ 30.00BOTH DaysBOTH Days\$ 50.00JUNIORS (one day)\$ 20.00JUNIORS (both days)\$ 35.00BBQ, Per Person\$ 5.00TEAM (includes team target service)\$ 80.00TARGET SERVICE\$ 20.00/dayMake checks payable to PBRSCEntry fee includes the \$5.50 NRA fee.This is an NRA REGISTERED match.
- CLASSIFICATION: BCRA or NRA, whichever is higher. Unclassified will shoot in the Master Class. F-Class has F-TR and F-Open classifications.
- CATEGORIES: <u>CANADIAN SERVICE RIFLE:</u> Military personnel of the Canadian Armed Forces firing the military service rifle MUST register in this category.

<u>U.S. SERVICE RIFLE:</u> Military personnel of the U.S. Armed Forces firing the military service rifle MUST register in this category.

<u>CIVILIAN SERVICE RIFLE:</u> Any civilian, NOT a member of the Armed Forces, firing a service rifle MUST register in this category.

<u>IRON SIGHT RIFLE:</u> A center fire rifle with metallic sights as per NRA Rule 3.3 or Canadian equivalent. Single shot rifles are acceptable. NO service rifle will be fired in this category.

ANY SIGHT RIFLE: Any center fire rifle NOT qualifying for any of the above categories.

F CLASS (Open and TR): Any center fire rifle and support as per NRA or BCRA F Class rules.

CATEGORY CHANGE: No competitor may change to another category once firing has begun. Changes from Saturday to Sunday must be made no later than check in on Sunday.

RULES: NRA rules are used, as nearly as possible.

COURSE of FIRE: All firing will be from the prone position.

Saturday & Sunday: (Rule 8.2)Matches 1 & 4Up to 5 SS and 20 record shots at 300 YARDS on the MR-63 target.25 minute time limit.Matches 2 & 52 SS and 20 record shots at 500 YARDS on the MR target.22 minute time limit.Matches 3 & 62 SS and 20 record shots at 600 YARDS on the MR-1 target.22 minute time limit.Monday: Teams only.2 SS and 15 record shots at 600 YARDS on the MR-1 target.77 minute block time.

- TARGET SERVICE: Competitors will PULL targets OR PROVIDE a target puller. If you wish to have a puller hired for you then you must indicate this on your pre-registration so the right number of kids can be hired. The team match on Monday will be run with paid target service only, if possible.
- TEAMS: Teams consist of 4 firing members. Categories include Any Sights, Iron Sights, and Service Rifle. A State or Province may have several teams in each category. An Any Sight team may include one F Class shooter. This shooter must have competed in the F Class Saturday or Sunday. Teams will be established Sunday. Competitors interested in being on a team should contact their Director. The highest scoring Iron Sight (or Service Rifle) and Any Sight teams for each State or Province will be combined to make an 8 Person Aggregate Team. We will have a U-25 category.
