Rules: Current NRA Highpower Rifle Rules will govern.

Eligibility: Open to any individual. Membership in the WSR&PA or your local State Association is encouraged but

not required. WSR&PA applications will be available.

Teams will consist of four firing members. A captain must be named (Rule 12.1).

Entries: Entries in individual events will be done on site. Advanced registration is not required but may be sent to

the address above. Make checks payable to Paul Bunyan R&S Club.

Entries are limited to 87 competitors. Post entries are accepted up to the stated range limit.

FEES: Fees include \$9.00 NRA Fee Adult / Junior Fees

Saturday only: 60 Shot Prone \$35.00/\$25.00 Sunday only: 80 Shot Regional Course \$40.00/\$25.00 Saturday & Sunday combined: (one cup & pin) \$60.00/\$35.00

Monday: Team match-per 4 person team (incl. \$6 NRA fee) \$40 (\$10 per competitor / day of match)

\$40 Team Target Service

Monday: EIC "Leg" Match \$15 (day of match)

Time of Firing: Firing will commence at 09:00 a.m. each day. **Souvenir Pins and cups** will be given to each individual competitor.

Squadding: All matches will be squadded. Competitors must check in at the statistical office to receive their

squadding and scorecards. NRA membership & classification will be checked during check in. Squadding information for team matches will be announced on the range. Competitors who fail to present themselves at the proper target point when their relay is called may lose their right to compete in

that event. Squadding will start at 07:30 a.m. Saturday and Sunday, 08:00 a.m. Monday.

Classification: The NRA classification system will be used. Unclassified competitors will compete in the Master class.

Assigned classification (rule 19.6) OR Temporary classifications (rule 19.2) may be used.

Rifles Allowed: NRA match rifle (rule 3.3) or service rifle (rule 3.1). Separate categories for Match rifle and service rifle

will be used. There will also be separate categories for Any Rifle, (shot all three stages), F-Class Open

and F-Class TR if the number of entries meet the awards criteria.

Targets: 200 yards - SR target, 300 yards - SR-3 target, 600 yards - MR-1 target. E-Targets may be used.

Sighting shots: Sighting shots allowed in the program must be taken and recorded (rule 9.2).

No sighting shots will be allowed in the team match #6.

Course of Fire: Friday, July 5 – Mid-Range Regional - 60 Shot Prone – 600 Yards

Match 601:unlimited sighting shots + 20 shots for record, prone30 minute time limit.Match 602:2 sighting shots + 20 shots for record, prone22 minute time limit.Match 603:2 sighting shots + 20 shots for record, prone22 minute time limit.

(Service Rifle shooters will use approved sights to be eligible for Service Rifle aggregate awards.)

Match 604: Dale Weiler Trophy Match - Aggregate of Matches 601, 602, and 603.

Course of Fire: Saturday, July 6 - 80 Shot Regional Course

Match 1: 2 sighting shots + 20 shots for record, standing, slow fire, 200 yards.

Match 2: 2 sighting shots + 20 shots for record, sitting or kneeling, rapid fire, 200 yards.

Match 3: 2 sighting shots + 20 shots for record, prone, rapid fire, 300 yards.

Match 4: 2 sighting shots + 20 shots for record, prone, slow fire, 600 yards.

Match 5: The Regional Championship: Aggregate of matches 1, 2, 3, and 4.

Course of Fire: Sunday, July 7 - 50 Shot NMC Team & EIC "Leg" Match

Match 6: 4-Person team match: The National Match Course - 10 shots standing, slow fire, 200 yards; 10 shots

sitting or kneeling, rapid fire, 200 yards; 10 shots prone, 300 yards; 20 shots prone, slow fire, 600 yards. **NO sighting shots will be allowed**. If possible this match will be shot with target service for all teams.

(\$40 per team)

Match 7: CMP Excellence in Competition Leg Match. The National Match Course as described for Match 6. For

eligibility and regulations governing match 7 refer to AR-920-30, AR-350-6 and AR 672-5-1.

Categories and classes in fired and aggregate matches: Separate awards will be given in each of two service rifle categories, civilian and military. The military category will include all reserve components, subject to the conditions of the awards schedule. All other categories will only have class awards.

Award Disposition: Matches 601, 602, 603, 1, 2, 3, and 4 - There must be 4 or more entries in a class/category for one award; 8 or more for 2 awards; 13 or more for 3 awards. If there are fewer than 4 High Masters entered, they must fire for open awards only. If there are fewer than the required number of entries in a class/category to provide the stage awards above then competitors will be combined with another category within that class except that F-Class and Any Rifle/Any Sight categories will remain separate.

If there are still fewer than 4 entries after combining all categories in a class, there will not be stage awards given in that class. All competitors in that class will be combined and shoot for aggregate awards only.

Matches 604, and 5 – Same as above except that there is no minimum number in a class for an award.

Awards: Matches 601, 602, 603, 1, 2, 3, and 4:

Match winner - \$15.00; 1st in class - \$10.00; 2nd in class - \$5.00; 3rd in class - \$3.00

Match 604 – Match Winner - Dale Weiler long range trophy + \$15 1^{st} in class - \$10.00; 2^{nd} in class - \$5.00; 3^{rd} in class - \$3.00

Match 5: The Regional Championship

Match Winner – Welker Memorial Trophy + \$25.00;

1st in class - \$10.00; 2nd in class - \$5.00; 3rd in class - \$3.00.

Regional Championship and Class medals as provided by the NRA. Camp Perry Entry Credits will be awarded according to NRA rules.

Match 6: NMC 4 Person Team Match

1st Place – Ten Dollars + NRA Medallion per shooter to highest scoring team. If 5 or more teams then the highest scoring Match Rifle and Service Rifle teams will each receive the \$10 per shooter.
