ACTION SHOOTING INTERNATIONAL (ASI)

Our last match for summer was on Sunday the 22nd due to scheduling conflicts on the calendar. There were 34 shooters, including, 4 new folks welcomed to our 'Move and Shoot' Sport. We had 5 ASI Stages, 67 round count, and 1 BONUS ASI stage.

For those unfamiliar – ASI has a set library of approved stages where stages are plucked from. The library has a variety of target arrays in the collection – many accommodate larger to smaller bays. Some have seated only, others include shooting around barricades or barrels. One-handed or off-hand starts may be part of the stage. Either way – there is plenty of opportunity to practice your handgun manipulations and proficiency.

Probably one of the greatest advantages ASI offers, is for those who are just learning how to Shoot and Move, is the availability of mentorship from the trained ASI range officers and seasoned shooters in your squad. ASI is a perfect place to start on the road to competition. It is also a great venue to practice with a new handgun or to work on skills, without the pressure of competition.

Our next match will be a Specialty Match held October 2 – The Senior Classic! It's an ASI sanctioned match – and opened to all but with special recognition for shooters 50 and older there will be awards. The breakdown will be: Senior (50- 59) Super Senior (60- 69) and High Elder (70- and onward!) We will have a Ladies category, along with High Law enforcement and Veteran (Active or retired).

You don't have to be a member of ASI to enter, either, but we will have information on the advantages of membership at the Stat Shack.
