Name Games – knowing names is powerful and inclusive

- Spelling Bee (2 minutes)
 - ✓ Say your name
 - ✓ Spell your name
 - ✓ Say your name
 - ✓ Use your name in a sentence

Starter Cards (15 minutes)

- Mix and mingle – share names and charades picture (2 minutes)
- Group of 4 – Sit, Stand, Crouch, Lie Down (3 minutes)
 - ✓ One player stands
 - ✓ One player sits
 - ✓ One player is in a crouch
 - ✓ One player lays down
 - ✓ If 5th player, they are a duck
- Group of 10 – Follow the Leader (5 minutes)
 - ✓ Choose a leader to introduce the next dance moves
 - ✓ Teammates follow along
- Group of 7 – Sense of Goose (5 minutes)
 - ✓ Efficiency
 - ✓ Trust
 - ✓ Teamwork
 - ✓ Encouragement
 - ✓ Compassion

Duck Thing (2 minutes)

- Right hand up if participating in a pledge
- Make circular motion
- Left hand up making a duck bill
- Turn duck bill toward your face
- Place on your chin

Toothpaste (3 minutes)

- Squeeze out some toothpaste onto a plate
- Invite 2 people to come up and put the toothpaste back in the tube
- Analogy is negative actions and words can be hard to take back

6 vs 9 (2 minutes)

- Create 2 face to face lines
- Place the numbers on the floor between the lines
- Ask players to shout out the first number they see
- Who is right?

1089 (5 minutes)

- Ask players to pick a three-digit number where all three numbers are unique: 274, 495, etc.
- Ask them to reverse the order of their number: 274 becomes 472
- Take the smaller three-digit number from the larger: $472-274=198$
- Take the answer and reverse that number: 198 becomes 891
- Add that number to the answer of the subtraction: $891+198=1089$
- When following the directions, the answer will be 1089 for all numbers.

New Perspective (3 minutes)

- Stand on a chair and look around
- Sometimes we need to see things from a different perspective

- Think about the last 3 winning Superbowl teams
- Think about 2 people who have won a Nobel peace prize
- Think about which movies have won the Best Picture the last 3 years
- List a few teachers who supported your journey through school.
- Name 3 friends who have helped you through a difficult time.
- Name 2 people who have taught you something worthwhile.

212 Degrees (2 minutes)

- Does anyone know what happens when water goes from 211 degrees to 212 degrees:
 - ✓ At 211 degrees, water is hot water.
 - ✓ At 212 degrees, water turns to steam.
 - ✓ This generated pressure and volume expansion of steam can power turbines in a power plant or move pistons in an engine.
 - ✓ This transition highlights how a seemingly small effort can have a massive impact.
- Ask each player to write down one small adjustment they can make that could lead to an improvement in their environment:
 - ✓ An extra acknowledgement to the janitor
 - ✓ A kind word to a colleague
 - ✓ Celebrating a small victory
 - ✓ Calling your students by name

Hat Game (5 minutes)

- Hand each player a hat with a character trait on it
- Players treat each other based on their character
