- Was enrolled as a fulltime student during the 2025-2026 academic school year
- Will be enrolled as a full-time student during the Fall or Spring Semester of the 2026-2027 academic school year.
- Has a current cumulative grade point average of at least a 2.5.
- · Can exhibit outstanding leadership abilities through specific activities and events.
- Is a U.S. Citizen or legal permanent resident with a valid permanent resident card or passport stamped I-551.

Submit two (2) letters of recommendation from teachers, religious and/or community leaders who are not related to you. The letters should reflect why you should be the recipient of the RLE Go Fore It! Foundation Scholarship Award.

The letters must be addressed to the Committee, signed, and must include the contact information (i.e., telephone number and email address) of the letters' writers, along with the writers' acquaintance to the applicant.
