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Introduction

These shocking bible verses will astonish you since they are not widely taught or known throughout the church.

Get ready to be amazed at what the Word of God says about the male genitalia.

Each of these verses is also connected to the Gospel and salvation of our Lord Jesus Christ.

***Whenever he slept
with his brother's
wife, he spilled his
semen on the
ground...***

Genesis 38:9, NIV

Then Judah took a wife for Er his firstborn, and her name was Tamar. But Er, Judah's firstborn, was wicked in the sight of the Lord, and the Lord killed him. And Judah said to Onan, "Go in to your brother's wife and marry her, and raise up an heir to your brother." But Onan knew that the heir would not be his; and it came to pass, when he went in to his brother's wife, that he emitted on the ground, lest he should give an heir to his brother. And the thing which he did displeased the Lord; therefore He killed him also.

Genesis 38:6-10, NKJV

Marriage is honorable. Whatever happens between the husband & his wife is acceptable (Hebrews 13:4). So, why was Onan's act wicked? – because Onan knew what was right and he did the opposite.

It was the duty of the living brother to carry on his deceased brother's lineage if he died without having any sons. The Sadducees argued with Jesus about this issue because they did not believe in resurrection from the dead. Jesus explained to them that we will not have marriages in the afterlife, but we will be like angels in heaven (Matthew 22:23-30). Our loved ones will not be the same as they

are now. We will not be the same. All of us will have glorified bodies.

Jesus lived, died, & now He lives again. The Spirit that resurrected Jesus shall raise us up to eternal life with Him. Therefore, present your body as a living sacrifice, holy and acceptable to God. All of us will give an account to God for what we do in this life. Spite, hate, envy, jealousy, & malice are not the fruit of a born-again believer filled with the Spirit of God. If it exists within your heart, repent and ask God to cleanse you. Whatever you do, do it all in the name of the Lord Jesus.

*If any man has an
emission of semen,
then he shall wash
all his body in water,
and be unclean until
evening.*

Leviticus 15:16, NKJV

If any man has an emission of semen, then he shall wash all his body in water, and be unclean until evening. And any garment and any leather on which there is semen, it shall be washed with water, and be unclean until evening. Also, when a woman lies with a man, and there is an emission of semen, they shall bathe in water, and be unclean until evening.

Leviticus 15:16-18, NKJV

Under the Old Covenant, many things were unclean and not allowed to be touched. There was much ceremonial cleansing during that time. The scribes and Pharisees considered everyone unclean who did not perform the ceremonial cleansings. However, Jesus explains that dirty hands do not defile a person, but the evil things that come from that person's heart defile him (Matthew 15:1-20).

Under the Old Covenant, cleansing was part of a works-based salvation. Being physically clean on the outside was required for God's acceptance.

However, under the New Covenant, we are saved by grace, not by our works. Our works are a product of our salvation, not a condition of it. The saving comes first. Then the works come after.

Water washing does not equal holiness in God's eyes. It only washes away germs & things rejected by man. God prefers clean hearts to clean hands and a clean conscience instead of a clean body. No matter how clean the body may be, if Jesus has not washed away your sins, you have no place in the resurrection to eternal life with God (1Peter 3:21-22).

*He who is emasculated by
crushing or mutilation shall
not enter the assembly of
the Lord. One of illegitimate
birth shall not enter the
assembly of the Lord; even
to the tenth generation none
of his descendants shall
enter the assembly of the
Lord.*

Deuteronomy 23:1-2, NKJV

There exists the belief that only the bloodline of Israelites will be saved and inherit eternal life.

That is a very dangerous misconception which can cause people to (1) believe that they are included in that group and (2) assume that their lineage is their ticket into eternal life in paradise.

Whoever believes on Jesus to forgive their sins will NOT be put to shame (Romans 10:11). Those who are born into the family need Jesus and those who are adopted into the family need Jesus. There is no distinction between the son and the

foreigner, but ALL must place their faith in Christ for forgiveness of sins.

Whoever has the Son has eternal life, but whoever does not have the Son does not have eternal life (1John 5:12). Under the New Covenant, God's mercy allows people with deformities and defects to place their faith in Jesus for eternal life (Matthew 18:8).

man, you must cut
off her hand.*

Deuteronomy 25:11, NLT

*If two men fight
together, and the wife of
one draws near to
rescue her husband
from the hand of the
one attacking him, and
puts out her hand and
seizes him by the
genitals, then you shall
cut off her hand; your
eye shall not pity her.*

Deuteronomy 25:11-12, NKJV

Under the Old Covenant, it was an eye for an eye and a tooth for a tooth. Whatever harm you sowed, it was up to the leaders to enforce that same harm upon you. If they did not uphold the law, they would be at fault and at risk of receiving punishment on themselves.

When Christ came, He did not make it acceptable for us to hurt people and not receive consequences, but He insists we don't seek our own revenge (Rom. 12:19). Jesus teaches us to have mercy, to forgive, & to turn the other cheek (Luke 6:27-36). If we do not forgive, we will not be forgiven.

So, what about when someone does something outrageous, terrible, and unforgivable? I believe that it's a matter of accountability and restitution. If they acknowledge their error, repent, accept discipline, & make amends, good. If they refuse, take it to the authority & let them handle that person (Matthew 18:15-17).

Ezekiel 23:20, NLT

*Yet she multiplied her
harlotry in calling to
remembrance the days of
her youth, when she had
played the harlot in the land
of Egypt. For she lusted for
her paramours, whose flesh
is like the flesh of donkeys,
and whose issue is like the
issue of horses. Thus you
called to remembrance the
lewdness of your youth,
when the Egyptians pressed
your bosom because of your
youthful breasts.*

Ezekiel 23:19-21, NKJV

This passage is figurative speech, but the other six passages in this book are interpreted literally. The children of God constantly went after other gods and idols, even after the Lord delivered them from harm and showed them favor.

This vivid comparison shows that God's people were only after the lusts of the eyes and the lusts of the flesh. Their hearts had turned away from serving God, the One who chose them and placed them above all the other nations.

There is always a choice on the table. We can choose to chase God, or we can choose to chase the things of the world. We can love God, or we can love the things of the world. The world will pass away, but whoever does the will of God lives forever. If you love the world, the Father's love is not in you (1John 2:15-17).

We cannot follow Jesus and follow the things of the world. They are headed in opposite directions.

*They have made
themselves eunuchs
for the kingdom of
heaven's sake.*

Matthew 19:12, NKJV

But He said to them, “All cannot accept this saying, but only those to whom it has been given: For there are eunuchs who were born thus from their mother’s womb, and there are eunuchs who were made eunuchs by men, and there are eunuchs who have made themselves eunuchs for the kingdom of heaven’s sake. He who is able to accept it, let him accept it.”

Matthew 19:11-12, NKJV

Eunuchs did not have testicles. There were 4 reasons for this: (1) they were born that way, (2) it was done as a punishment from men, (3) it was done so they could serve in the women's area of the royal places, or (4) men did it to themselves for their service to the Lord.

Someone might ask why a man would do that to himself. However, if you believe that life without sexual pleasure is not worth living, you prove the eunuch's point. His goal is to please God by all means, and that includes removing any and all possible distractions.

Marriage & sex are things of the world (1Cor. 7:32-33), and we can live without them. Some people are willing to give up everything for the Lord, but some are not willing to give up anything. If you love anything or anyone, even your family, friends, or loved ones, more than you love Jesus, you cannot be His disciple (Matthew 10:37, Luke 14:26).

Galatians 5:12, ISV

I have confidence in you, in the Lord, that you will have no other mind; but he who troubles you shall bear his judgment, whoever he is.

And I, brethren, if I still preach circumcision, why do I still suffer persecution?

Then the offense of the cross has ceased. I could wish that those who trouble you would even cut themselves off!

Galatians 5:10-12, NKJV

Paul, the author of this epistle, got so emotional at times that he would not hold back his words. He spoke what was on his mind, but at the same time, he continued being a representative of Christ, not practicing sin in his writings or his speech.

This subject irritated Paul because the Jews were trying to force circumcision on the Christian believers. Paul was adamant in his teachings that circumcision was not mandatory for salvation and eternal life in Christ Jesus. He went on to say that those desiring to circumcise the foreskins of the churches in

Galatia should cut themselves off beyond the foreskin.

The Lord does not require penal circumcision under the New Covenant. He wants us to circumcise the foreskin of our heart (Deuteronomy 10:16), to put away the idols and the sin which separate us from Him.
