## **STARI**

**STARI** is a literature-focused, Tier II (small group) intervention for students in grades 6-9 who read two or more years below grade level.

Using research-based practices and highly engaging texts, STARI addresses gaps in **fluency**, **decoding**, **reading stamina**, **and comprehension**, aiming to move struggling students to higher levels of proficiency at the end of one year.

STARI was tested in a large-scale randomised trial across four US districts in the 2013-2014 school year.

STARI students outperformed students in the control group on all six subtests, even though the large majority of control group students received other reading interventions.

Evaluation of STARI was led by James Kim (Harvard University).
